Moderate levels of influenza-like illness activity


This survey was sent on Monday, 18 September 2017 at 01:13 AM and by 09:00 AM, Thursday 21 September we had received 25059 responses (25515 last week) from 15024 people responding for themselves and 10035 household members across Australia.



Across Australia, fever and cough was reported by 2.2% of vaccinated participants and 3.0% of unvaccinated participants. Fever, cough and absence from normal duties was reported by 1.7% of vaccinated participants and 2.3% of unvaccinated participants.

For participants this week, 15799/25059 (63.0 %) have received the seasonal vaccine so far. Of the 4632 participants who identified as working face-to-face with patients, 3755 (81.1%) have received the vaccine.
