Low levels of influenza-like illness activity


This survey was sent on Monday, 25 September 2017 at 01:13 AM and by 09:00 AM, Thursday 28 September we had received 23575 responses (25233 last week) from 14239 people responding for themselves and 9336 household members across Australia.

Respondent Numbers by Jurisdiction



Across Australia, fever and cough was reported by 2.0% of vaccinated participants and 2.4% of unvaccinated participants. Fever, cough and absence from normal duties was reported by 1.6% of vaccinated participants and 1.9% of unvaccinated participants.

For participants this week, 14959/23575 (63.5 %) have received the seasonal vaccine so far. Of the 4361 participants who identified as working face-to-face with patients, 3552 (81.4%) have received the vaccine.
