Low levels of influenza-like illness activity


This survey was sent on Monday, 02 October 2017 at 01:13 AM and by 09:00 AM, Thursday 05 October we had received 22337 responses (23716 last week) from 13488 people responding for themselves and 8849 household members across Australia.

Respondent Numbers by Jurisdiction



Across Australia, fever and cough was reported by 1.9% of vaccinated participants and 1.8% of unvaccinated participants. Fever, cough and absence from normal duties was reported by 1.3% of vaccinated participants and 1.2% of unvaccinated participants.

For participants this week, 14134/22337 (63.3 %) have received the seasonal vaccine so far. Of the 4015 participants who identified as working face-to-face with patients, 3258 (81.1%) have received the vaccine.
