Low levels of influenza-like illness activity


This survey was sent on Monday, 28 May 2018 at 01:13 AM and by 09:00 AM, Thursday 31 May we had received 34422 responses (34142 last week) from 20040 people responding for themselves and 14382 household members across Australia.

Across Australia, fever and cough was reported by 1.9% of vaccinated participants and 1.9% of unvaccinated participants. Fever, cough and absence from normal duties was reported by 1.3% of vaccinated participants and 1.3% of unvaccinated participants.

For participants this week, 19917/34422 (57.9 %) have received the seasonal vaccine so far. Of the 5964 participants who identified as working face-to-face with patients, 4366 (73.2%) have received the vaccine.
