



## Week ending 10 June 2018

**Moderate levels of influenza-like illness activity**  
**(Current low numbers of participants in NZ could prevent Flutracking from providing a representative picture in NZ. Care should be taken when interpreting this report)**

This survey was sent on Monday, 11 June 2018 at 03:13 AM and by 09:00 AM, Thursday 14 June we had received 1586 responses (1398 last week) from 835 people responding for themselves and 751 household members across New Zealand.

### Respondent Numbers by Jurisdiction


Across New Zealand, fever and cough was reported by 4.0% of vaccinated participants and 2.9% of unvaccinated participants. Fever, cough and absence from normal duties was reported by 2.8% of vaccinated participants and 1.8% of unvaccinated participants.

For participants this week, 1003/1586 (63.2 %) have received the seasonal vaccine so far. Of the 182 participants who identified as working face-to-face with patients, 159 (87.4%) have received the vaccine.
