Low levels of influenza-like illness activity


This survey was sent on Monday, 18 June 2018 at 01:13 AM and by 09:00 AM, Thursday 21 June we had received 34604 responses (34169 last week) from 20287 people responding for themselves and 14317 household members across Australia.



Across Australia, fever and cough was reported by 1.7% of vaccinated participants and 1.8% of unvaccinated participants. Fever, cough and absence from normal duties was reported by 1.1% of vaccinated participants and 1.2% of unvaccinated participants.

For participants this week, 22461/34604 (64.9 %) have received the seasonal vaccine so far. Of the 5940 participants who identified as working face-to-face with patients, 4826 (81.2%) have received the vaccine.
