Moderate levels of influenza-like illness activity
(Current low numbers of participants in NZ could prevent Flutracking from providing a representative picture in NZ. Care should be taken when interpreting this report)

This survey was sent on Monday, 18 June 2018 at 03:13 AM and by 11:00 AM, Thursday 21 June we had received 1899 responses (1613 last week) from 990 people responding for themselves and 909 household members across New Zealand.


Across New Zealand, fever and cough was reported by 3.8% of vaccinated participants and 5.3% of unvaccinated participants. Fever, cough and absence from normal duties was reported by 2.9% of vaccinated participants and 3.8% of unvaccinated participants.

For participants this week, 1211/1899 (63.8 %) have received the seasonal vaccine so far. Of the 218 participants who identified as working face-to-face with patients, 188 (86.2%) have received the vaccine.
