Moderate levels of influenza-like illness activity

This survey was sent on Monday, 02 July 2018 at 03:13 AM and by 09:00 AM, Thursday 05 July we had received 2353 responses (2055 last week) from 1257 people responding for themselves and 1096 household members across New Zealand.



Across New Zealand, fever and cough was reported by 2.2% of vaccinated participants and 4.8% of unvaccinated participants. Fever, cough and absence from normal duties was reported by 1.8% of vaccinated participants and 3.5% of unvaccinated participants.

For participants this week, 1489/2353 (63.3 %) have received the seasonal vaccine so far. Of the 293 participants who identified as working face-to-face with patients, 247 (84.3%) have received the vaccine.
