# Weekly Interim Report New Zealand

**Week ending 08 July 2018**

## Moderate levels of influenza-like illness activity

**(Current low numbers of participants in NZ could prevent Flutracking from providing a representative picture in NZ. Care should be taken when interpreting this report)**

This survey was sent on Monday, 09 July 2018 at 03:13 AM and by 09:00 AM, Wednesday 11 July we had received 2378 responses (2290 last week) from 1277 people responding for themselves and 1101 household members across New Zealand.

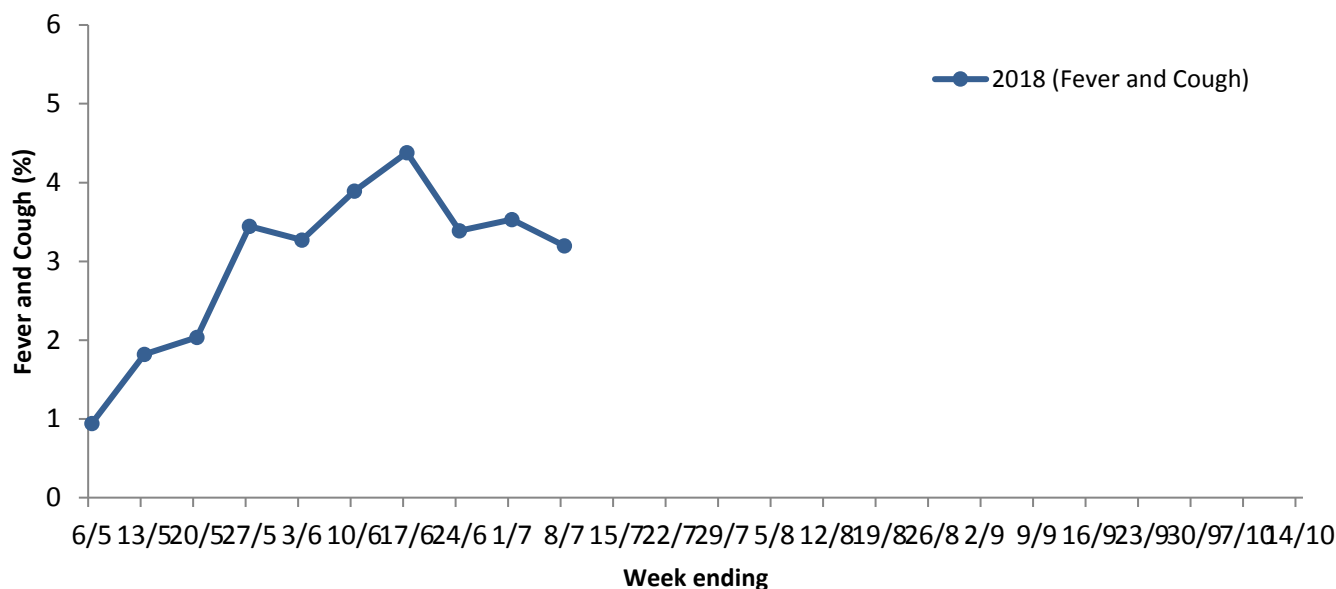

Across New Zealand, fever and cough was reported by 2.5% of vaccinated participants and 4.4% of unvaccinated participants. Fever, cough and absence from normal duties was reported by 1.7% of vaccinated participants and 4.1% of unvaccinated participants.

For participants this week, 1528/2378 (64.3 %) have received the seasonal vaccine so far. Of the 301 participants who identified as working face-to-face with patients, 257 (85.4%) have received the vaccine.
