Low levels of influenza-like illness activity

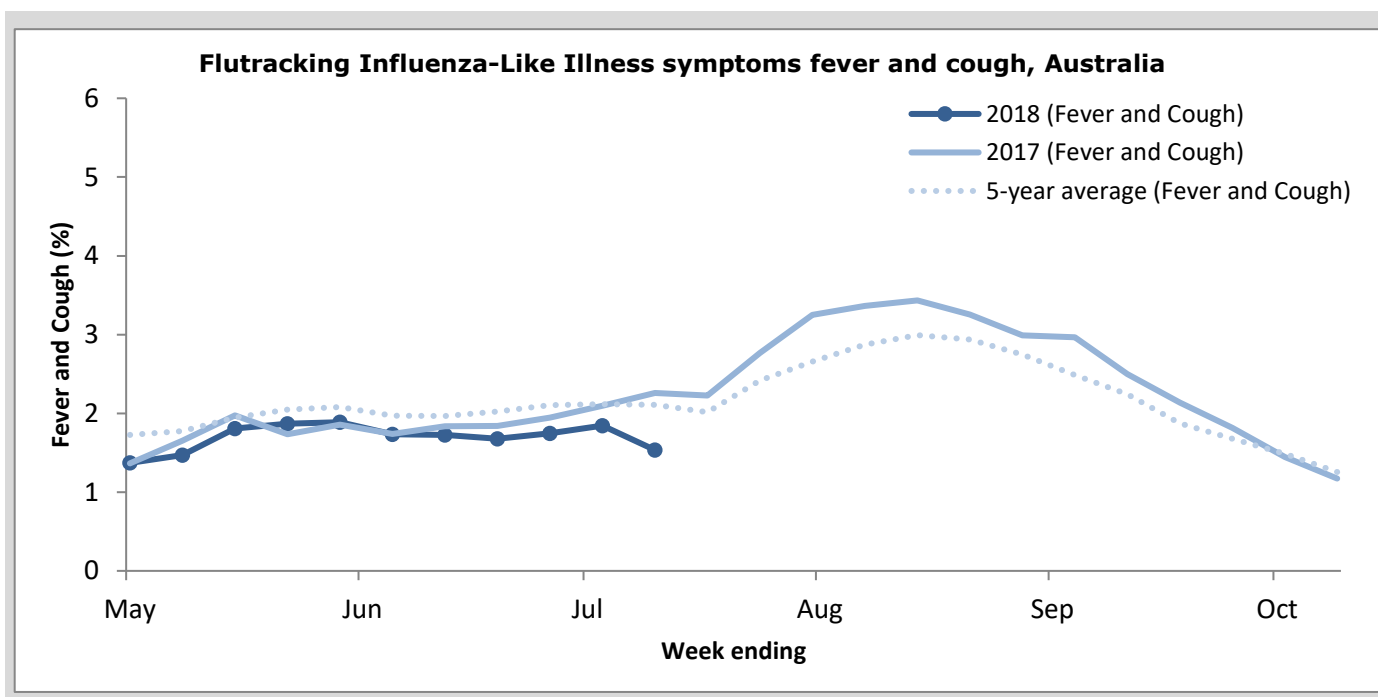
This survey was sent on Monday, 16 July 2018 at 01:13 AM and by 09:00 AM, Thursday 19 July we had received 33891 responses (33892 last week) from 19998 people responding for themselves and 13893 household members across Australia.

Across Australia, fever and cough was reported by 1.6% of vaccinated participants and 1.4% of unvaccinated participants. Fever, cough and absence from normal duties was reported by 1.1% of vaccinated participants and 0.9% of unvaccinated participants.

For participants this week, 22835/33891 (67.4 %) have received the seasonal vaccine so far. Of the 5799 participants who identified as working face-to-face with patients, 4835 (83.4%) have received the vaccine.
