Weekly Interim Report New Zealand

Week ending 15 July 2018

Moderate levels of influenza-like illness activity

(Current low numbers of participants in NZ could prevent Flutracking from providing a representative picture in NZ. Care should be taken when interpreting this report)

This survey was sent on Monday, 16 July 2018 at 03:13 a.m. and by 09:00 a.m., Thursday 19 July we had received 2501 responses (2475 last week) from 1355 people responding for themselves and 1146 household members across New Zealand.

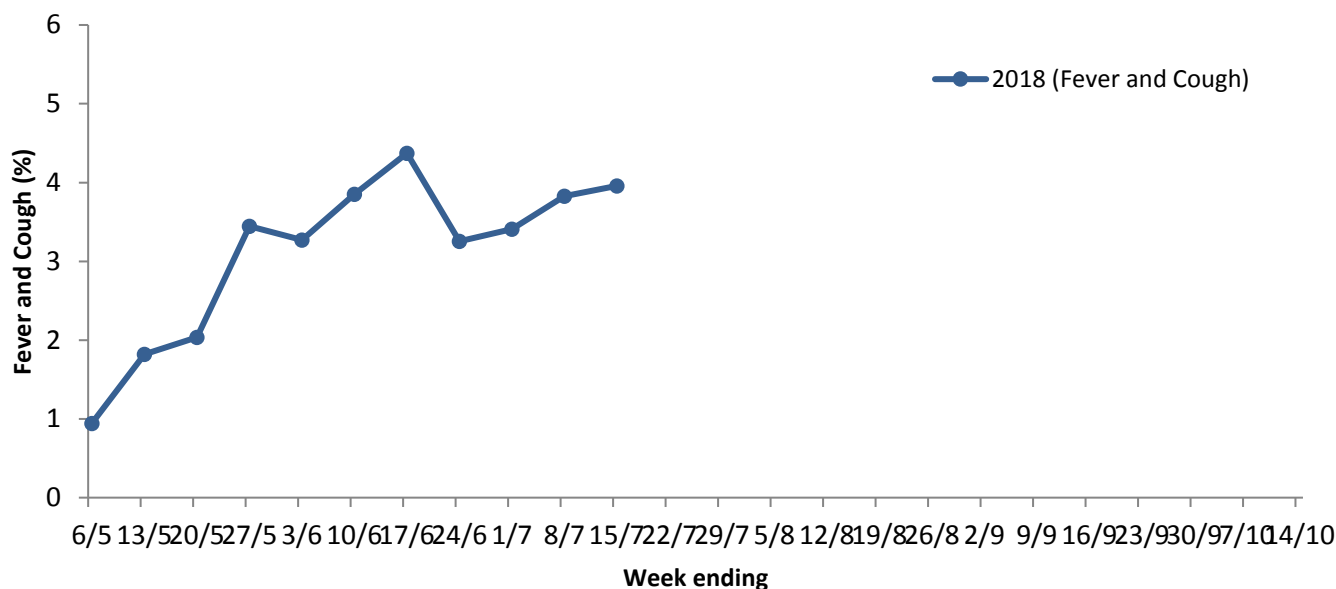

Across New Zealand, fever and cough was reported by 3.3% of vaccinated participants and 5.0% of unvaccinated participants. Fever, cough and absence from normal duties was reported by 2.0% of vaccinated participants and 3.8% of unvaccinated participants.

For participants this week, 1605/2501 (64.2 %) have received the seasonal vaccine so far. Of the 324 participants who identified as working face-to-face with patients, 272 (84.0%) have received the vaccine.
