



**Week ending 22 July 2018**

**High levels of influenza-like illness activity**

**(Current low numbers of participants in NZ could prevent Flutracking from providing a representative picture in NZ. Care should be taken when interpreting this report)**

This survey was sent on Monday, 23 July 2018 at 03:13 AM and by 09:00 AM, Thursday 26 July we had received 2793 responses (2528 last week) from 1493 people responding for themselves and 1300 household members across New Zealand.


**Respondent Numbers by Jurisdiction**

State	Respondents	Percentage
North Island	2147	76.9%
South Island	646	23.1%
New Zealand	2793	100.0%

Across New Zealand, fever and cough was reported by 3.1% of vaccinated participants and 6.0% of unvaccinated participants. Fever, cough and absence from normal duties was reported by 2.4% of vaccinated participants and 4.4% of unvaccinated participants.

For participants this week, 1779/2793 (63.7 %) have received the seasonal vaccine so far. Of the 349 participants who identified as working face-to-face with patients, 295 (84.5%) have received the vaccine.
