# Weekly Interim Report Australia

## Low levels of influenza-like illness activity

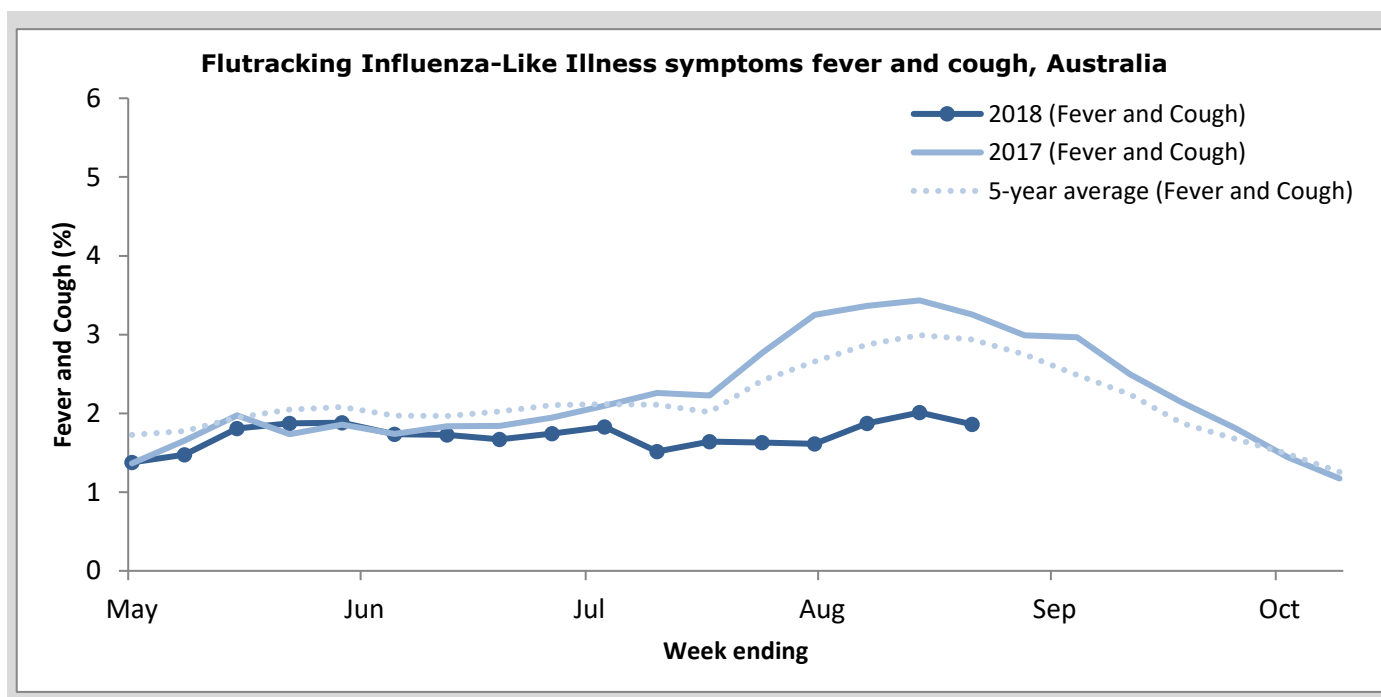
This survey was sent on Monday, 27 August 2018 at 01:13 AM and by 09:00 AM, Thursday 30 August we had received 31789 responses (34193 last week) from 18661 people responding for themselves and 13128 household members across Australia.

Across Australia, fever and cough was reported by 1.8% of vaccinated participants and 1.9% of unvaccinated participants. Fever, cough and absence from normal duties was reported by 1.2% of vaccinated participants and 1.3% of unvaccinated participants.

For participants this week, 21842/31789 (68.7 %) have received the seasonal vaccine so far. Of the 5470 participants who identified as working face-to-face with patients, 4638 (84.8%) have received the vaccine.
