**Moderate levels of influenza-like illness activity
(Current low numbers of participants in NZ could prevent Flutracking from providing a representative picture in NZ. Care should be taken when interpreting this report)**

This survey was sent on Monday, 03 September 2018 at 03:13 a.m. and by 09:00 a.m., Thursday 06 September we had received 3297 responses (3450 last week) from 1790 people responding for themselves and 1507 household members across New Zealand.


Respondent Numbers by Jurisdiction

North Island	2521	76.5%
South Island	776	23.5%
New Zealand	3297	100.0%

Across New Zealand, fever and cough was reported by 2.4% of vaccinated participants and 4.0% of unvaccinated participants. Fever, cough and absence from normal duties was reported by 2.2% of vaccinated participants and 3.8% of unvaccinated participants.

For participants this week, 2130/3297 (64.6 %) have received the seasonal vaccine so far. Of the 416 participants who identified as working face-to-face with patients, 352 (84.6%) have received the vaccine.
