



FluTracking Weekly Interim Report New Zealand

Week ending 05 May 2019

Low levels of influenza-like illness activity

(Current low numbers of participants in NZ could prevent Flutracking from providing a representative picture in NZ. Care should be taken when interpreting this report)

This survey was sent on Monday, 06 May 2019 at 03:01 AM and by 09:00 AM, Thursday 09 May we had received 4052 responses (4151 last week) from 2296 people responding for themselves and 1756 household members across New Zealand.

Respondent Numbers by Jurisdiction



South Island	1016	25.1%
New Zealand	4052	100.0%

Across New Zealand, fever and cough was reported by 1.3% of vaccinated participants and 1.5% of unvaccinated participants. Fever, cough and absence from normal duties was reported by 0.8% of vaccinated participants and 1.1% of unvaccinated participants.

For participants this week, 2000/4052 (49.4 %) have received the seasonal vaccine so far. Of the 558 participants who identified as working face-to-face with patients, 406 (72.8%) have received the vaccine.
