# Weekly Interim Report New Zealand

**Week ending 23 June 2019**

## Moderate levels of influenza-like illness activity

**(Current low numbers of participants in NZ could prevent Flutracking from providing a representative picture in NZ. Care should be taken when interpreting this report)**

This survey was sent on Monday, 24 June 2019 at 03:01 AM and by 09:00 AM, Thursday 27 June we had received 4429 responses (4543 last week) from 2479 people responding for themselves and 1950 household members across New Zealand.

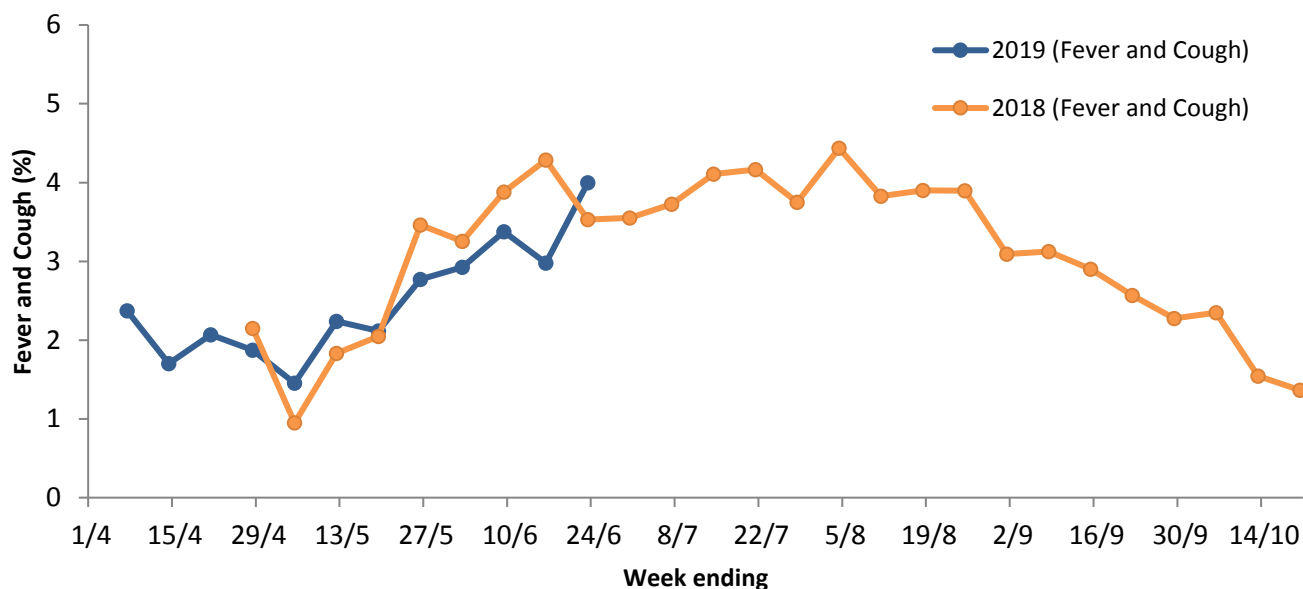

Across New Zealand, fever and cough was reported by 3.4% of vaccinated participants and 5.1% of unvaccinated participants. Fever, cough and absence from normal duties was reported by 2.5% of vaccinated participants and 4.3% of unvaccinated participants.

For participants this week, 2945/4429 (66.5 %) have received the seasonal vaccine so far. Of the 600 participants who identified as working face-to-face with patients, 515 (85.8%) have received the vaccine.
