Week ending 30 June 2019

Moderate levels of influenza-like illness activity

This survey was sent on Monday, 01 July 2019 at 03:01 AM and by 09:00 AM, Thursday 04 July we had received 4368 responses (4468 last week) from 2441 people responding for themselves and 1927 household members across New Zealand.



Across New Zealand, fever and cough was reported by 2.8% of vaccinated participants and 4.8% of unvaccinated participants. Fever, cough and absence from normal duties was reported by 2.4% of vaccinated participants and 3.9% of unvaccinated participants.

For participants this week, 2897/4368 (66.3 %) have received the seasonal vaccine so far. Of the 582 participants who identified as working face-to-face with patients, 507 (87.1%) have received the vaccine.
