Low levels of influenza-like illness activity

(Current low numbers of participants in NZ could prevent Flutracking from providing a representative picture in NZ. Care should be taken when interpreting this report)

This survey was sent on Monday, 29 July 2019 at 03:01 a.m. and by 09:00 a.m., Thursday 01 August we had received 4244 responses (4331 last week) from 2384 people responding for themselves and 1860 household members across New Zealand.

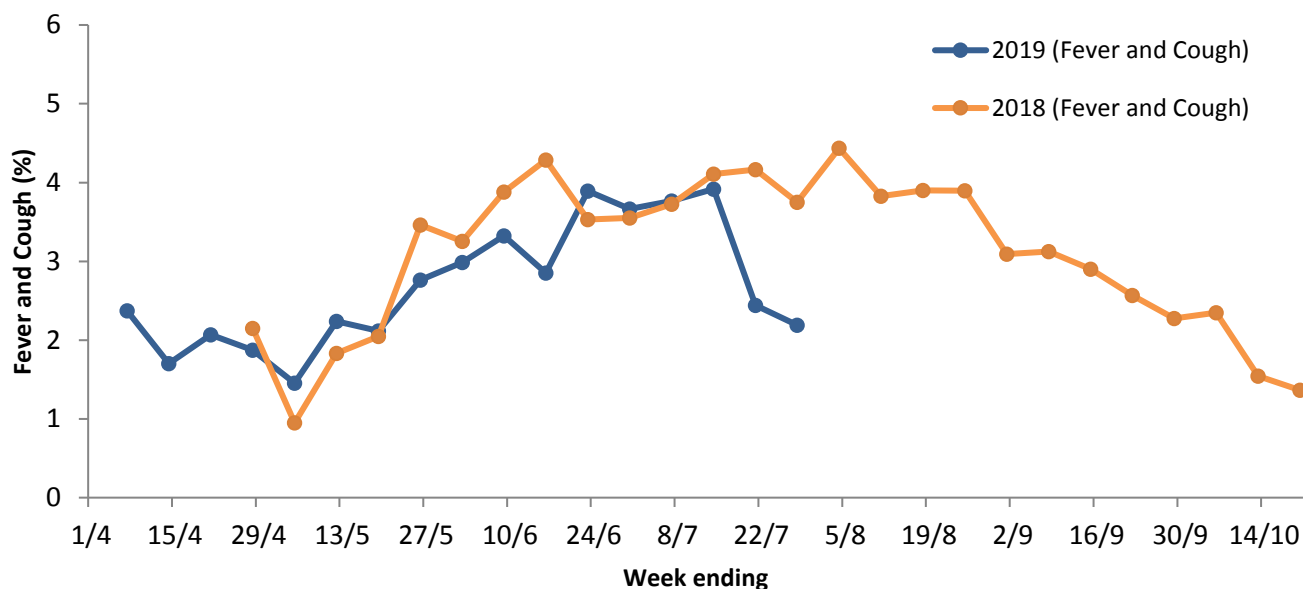

Across New Zealand, fever and cough was reported by 2.1% of vaccinated participants and 2.4% of unvaccinated participants. Fever, cough and absence from normal duties was reported by 1.7% of vaccinated participants and 1.7% of unvaccinated participants.

For participants this week, 2904/4244 (68.4 %) have received the seasonal vaccine so far. Of the 571 participants who identified as working face-to-face with patients, 505 (88.4%) have received the vaccine.
