Low levels of influenza-like illness activity

(Current low numbers of participants in NZ could prevent FluTracking from providing a representative picture in NZ. Care should be taken when interpreting this report)

This survey was sent on Monday, 12 August 2019 at 03:01 AM and by 09:00 AM, Thursday 15 August we had received 4228 responses (4363 last week) from 2382 people responding for themselves and 1846 household members across New Zealand.

Respondent Numbers by Jurisdiction



South Island	1039	24.6%
New Zealand	4228	100.0%

Across New Zealand, fever and cough was reported by 2.3% of vaccinated participants and 3.2% of unvaccinated participants. Fever, cough and absence from normal duties was reported by 1.7% of vaccinated participants and 3.1% of unvaccinated participants.

For participants this week, 2886/4228 (68.3 %) have received the seasonal vaccine so far. Of the 550 participants who identified as working face-to-face with patients, 481 (87.5%) have received the vaccine.
