



FluTracking Weekly Interim Report New Zealand

Week ending 3 May 2020

Low levels of Influenza-like illness (ILI) activity

(FluTracking is an online **self-reporting** ILI surveillance system. Care should be taken when interpreting this report)

This survey was sent on Monday, 4 May 2020 at 03:01 a.m. and by 09:00 a.m., Thursday, 7 May we had received 62663 responses (62392 last week) from 30290 people responding for themselves and 32373 household members across New Zealand.

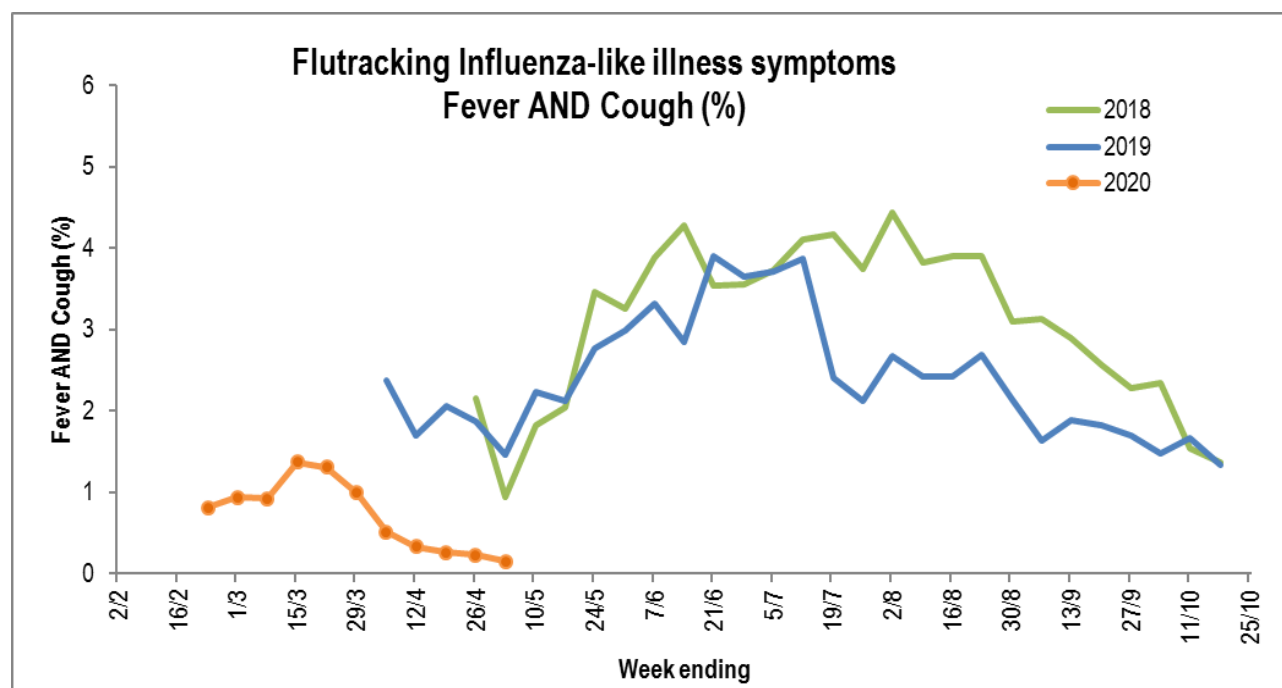
Across New Zealand, fever and cough was reported by 0.15% participants. Fever, cough and absence from normal duties was reported by 0.1% participants. Fever AND Cough was reported by 0.2% of participants aged less than 5 years, 0.1% of participants aged 5-17 years, 0.2% of participants aged 18-64 years, and 0.1% of participants aged 65 years or older.

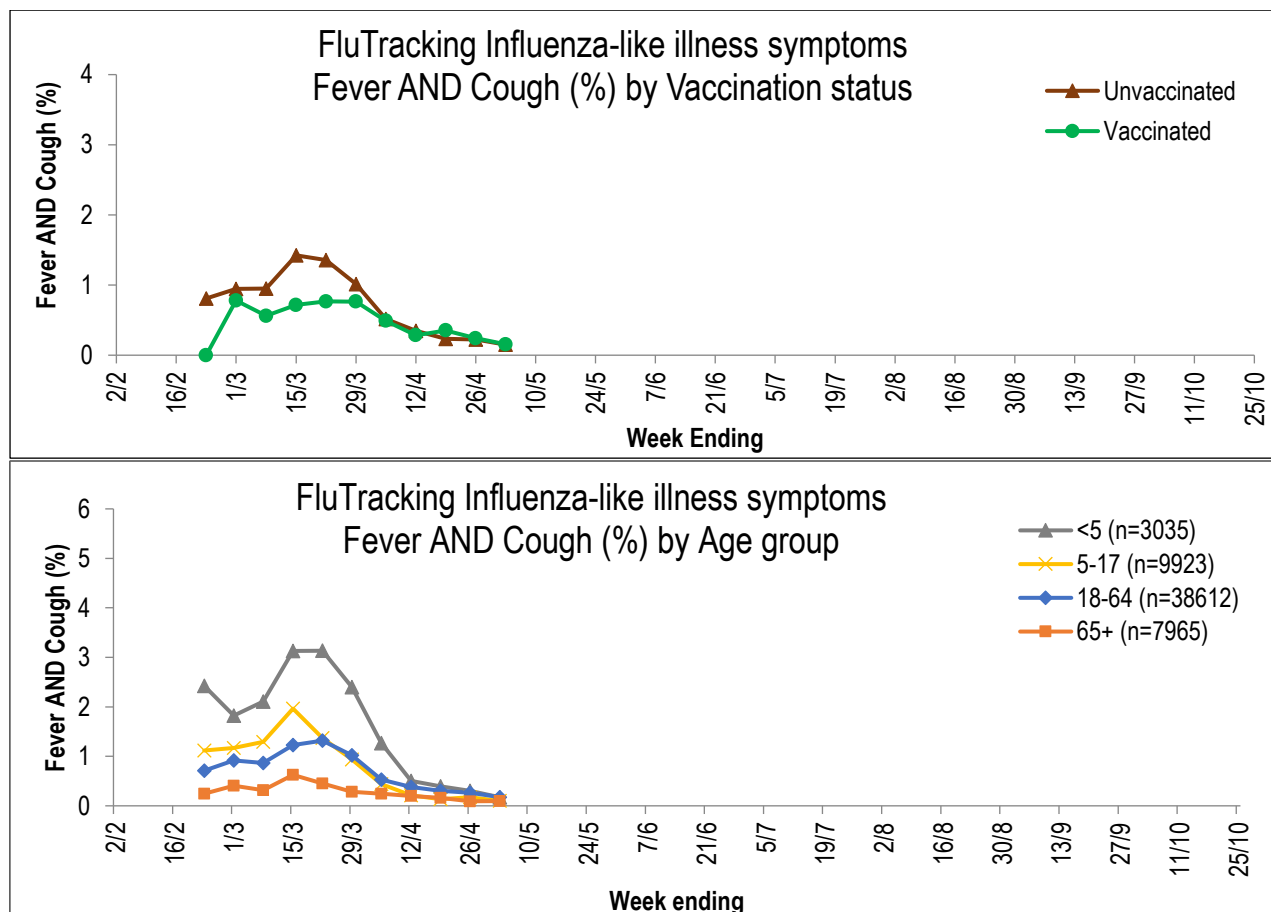
