



FluTracking Weekly Interim Report New Zealand

Week ending 21 June 2020

Low levels of Influenza-like illness (ILI) activity

(FluTracking is an online **self-reporting** ILI surveillance system. Care should be taken when interpreting this report)

This survey was sent on Monday, 22 June 2020 at 03:01 a.m. and by 09:00 a.m., Thursday 25 June we had received 55189 responses (55901 last week) from 27471 people responding for themselves and 27718 household members across New Zealand.

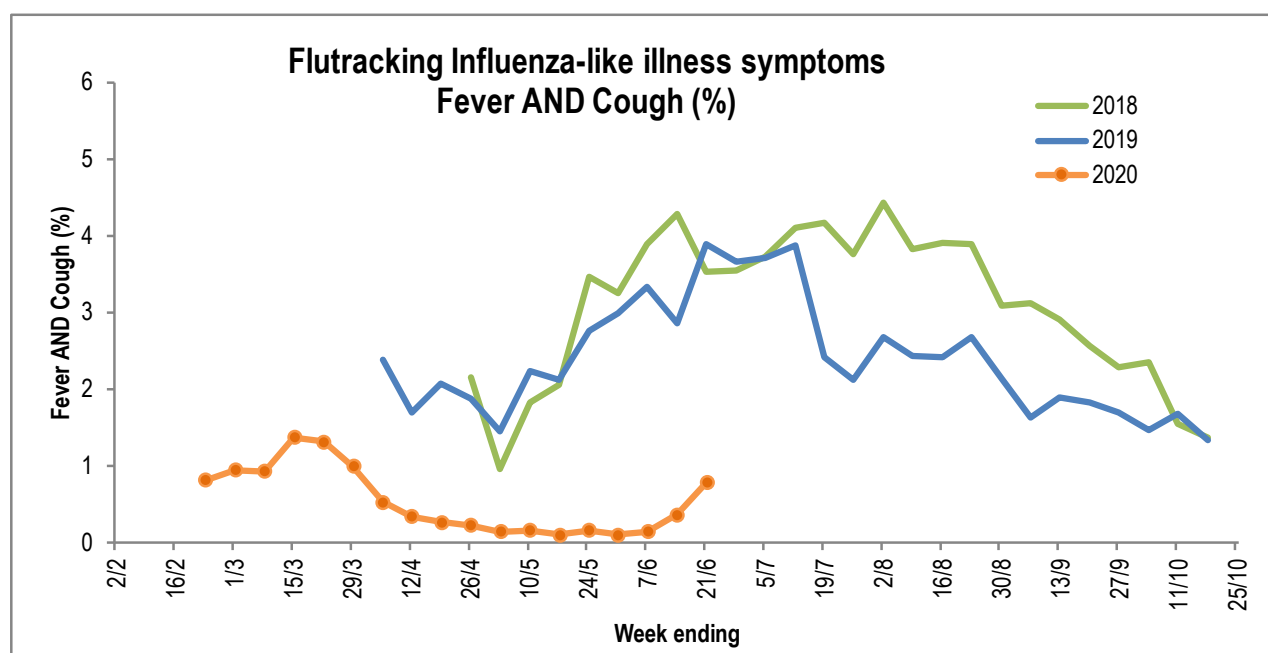
Across New Zealand, fever and cough was reported by 0.8% participants. Fever, cough and absence from normal duties was reported by 0.6% participants. Fever and cough was reported by 3.7% of participants aged less than 5 years, 1.4% of participants aged 5-17 years, 0.6% of participants aged 18-64 years, and 0.2% of participants aged 65 years or older.

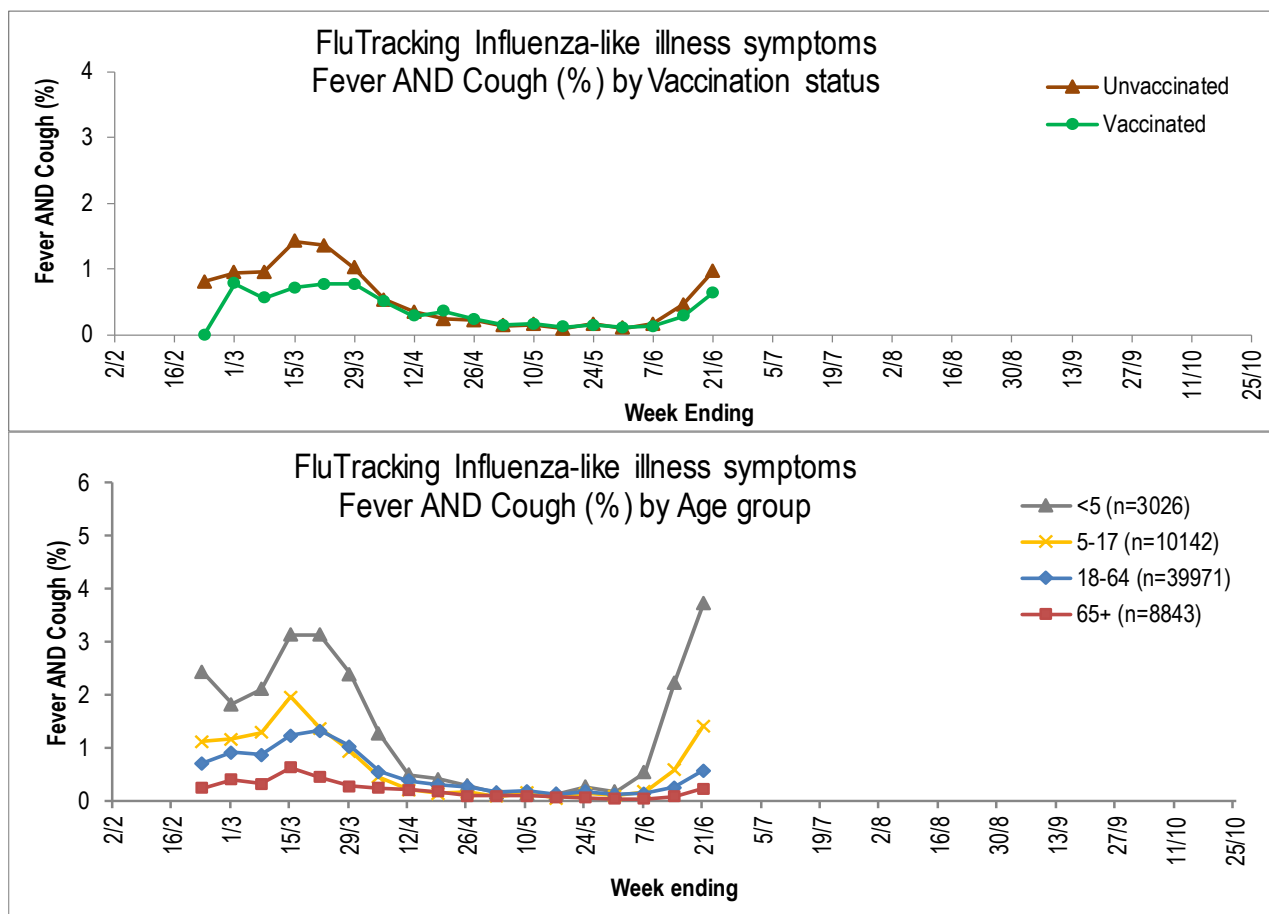
