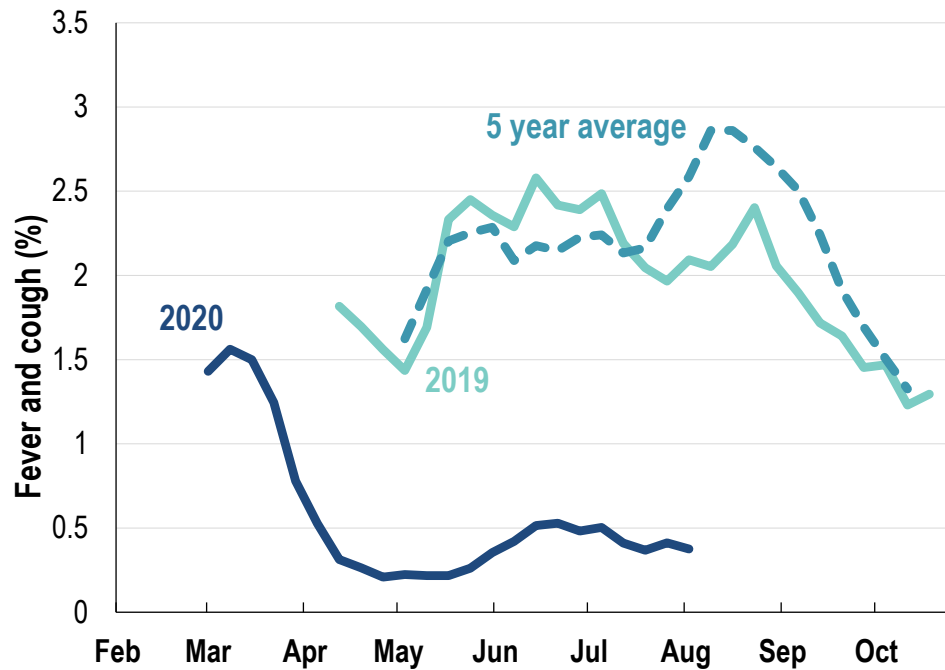

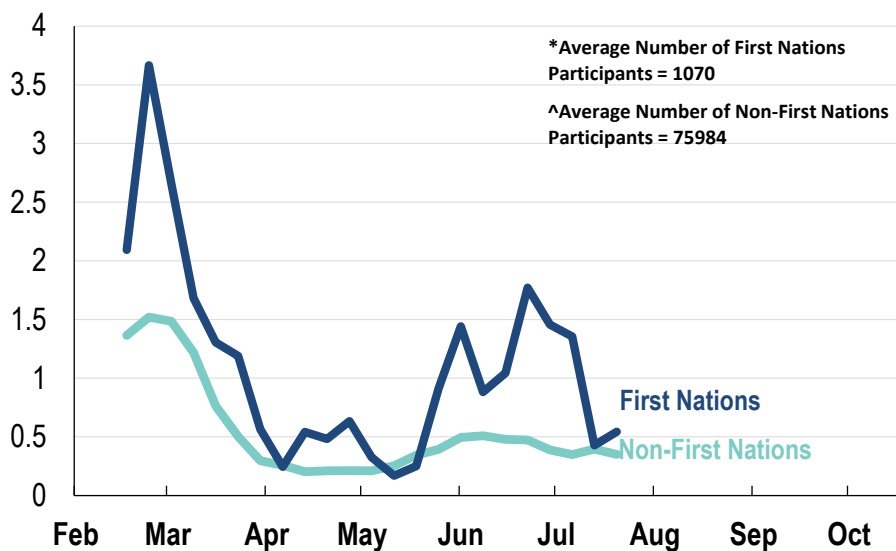
Influenza-like illness activity:

Participants = 75984

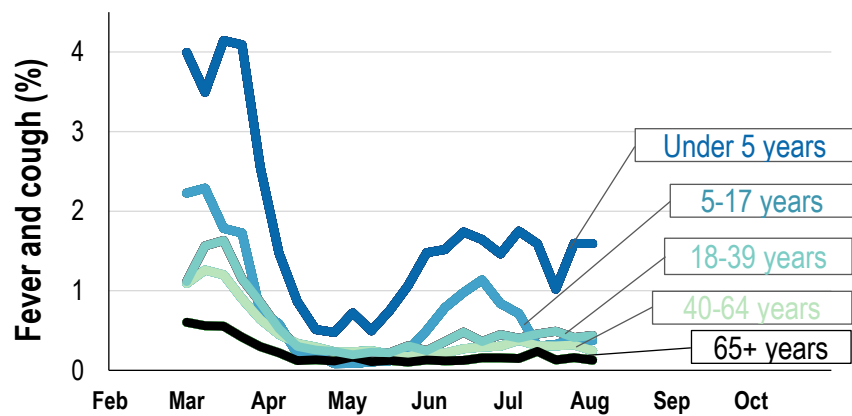

64.4% of participants with fever and cough sought medical advice this week

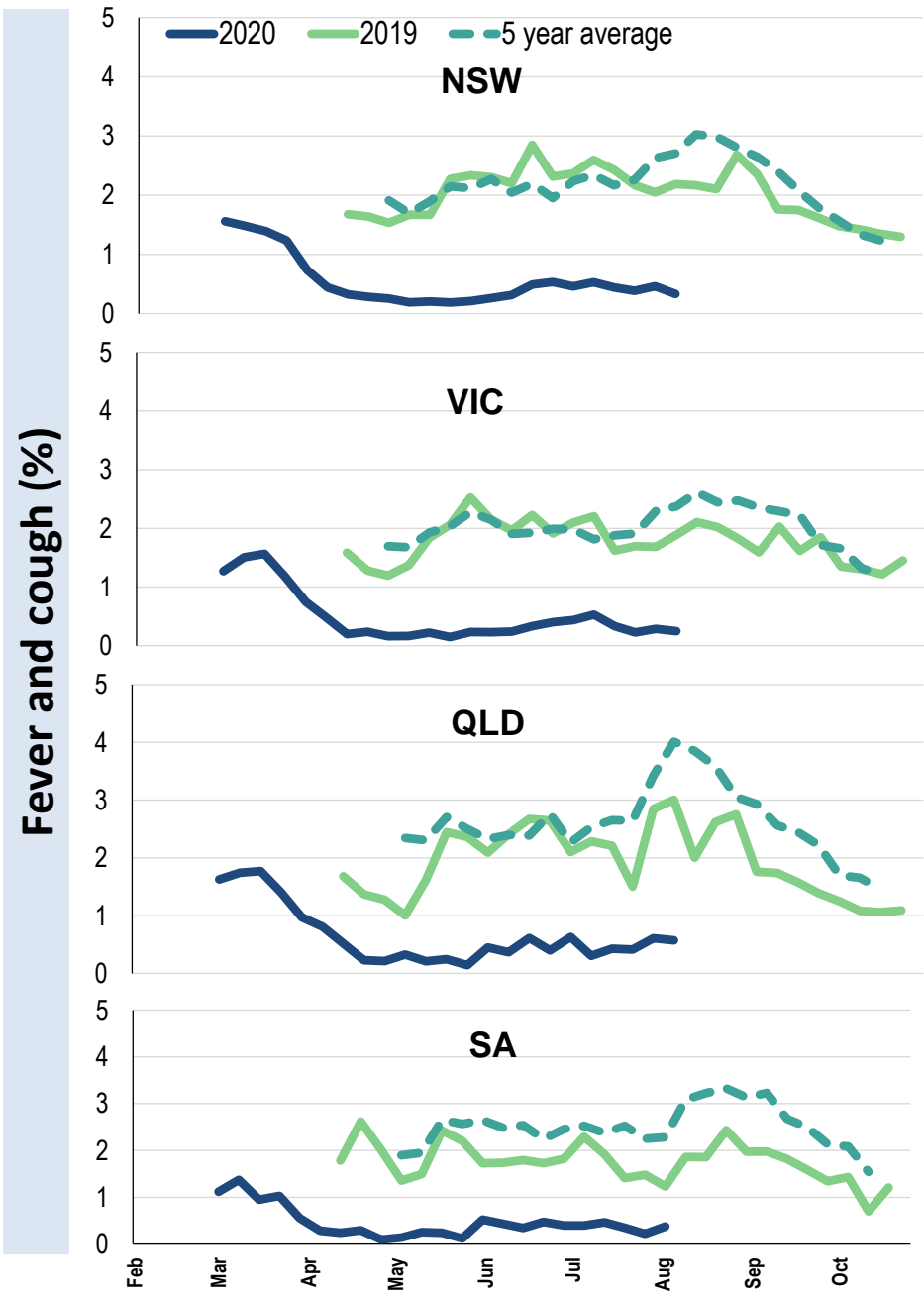

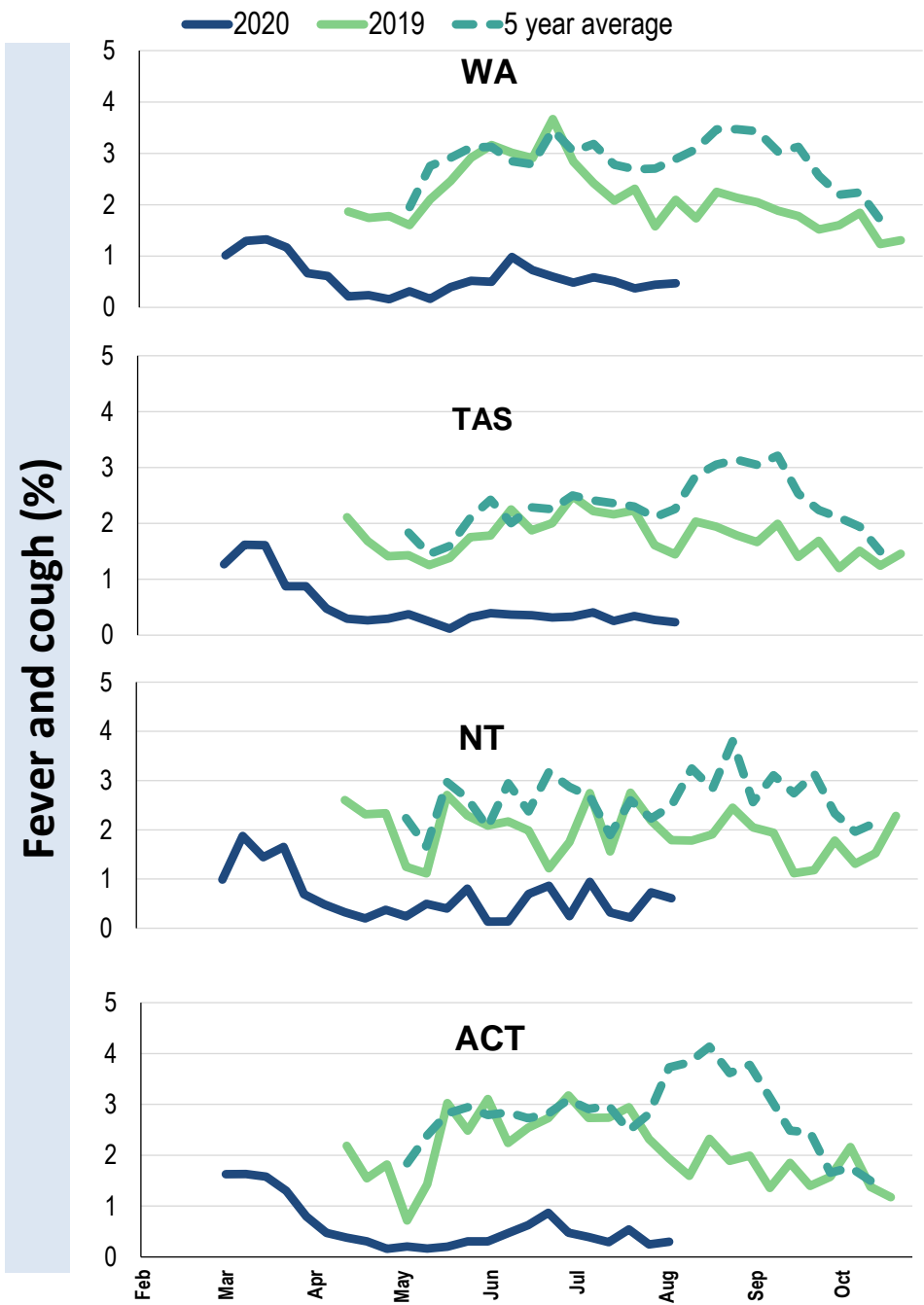
Influenza-like illness activity by age group (Australia):

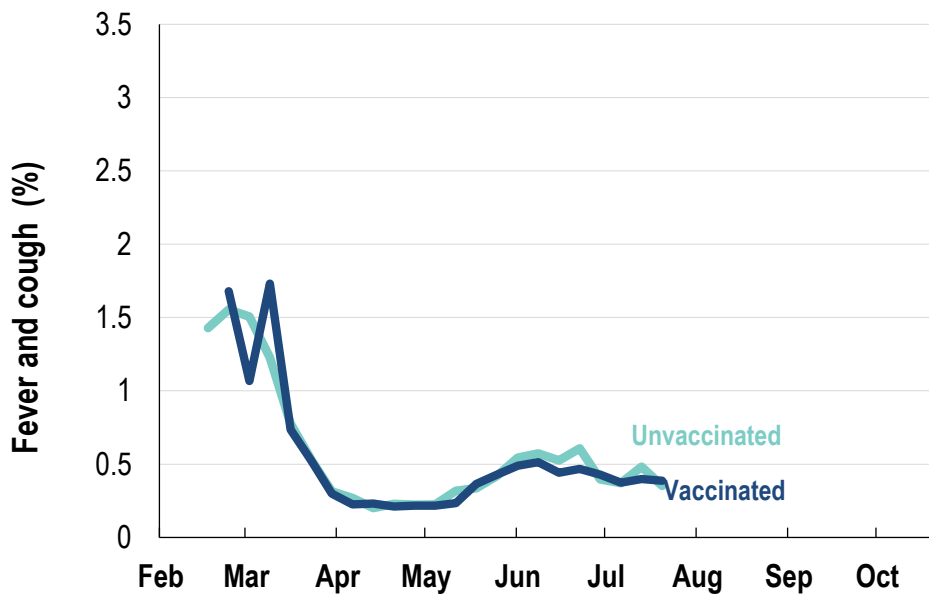
