



FluTracking Weekly Interim Report New Zealand

Week ending 11 October 2020

Low levels of Influenza-like illness (ILI) activity

(FluTracking is an online **self-reporting** ILI surveillance system. Care should be taken when interpreting this report)

This survey was sent on Monday, 12 October 2020 and by Thursday, 15 October 2020 we had received 45920 responses (45888 last week) from 23898 people responding for themselves and 22022 household members across New Zealand.

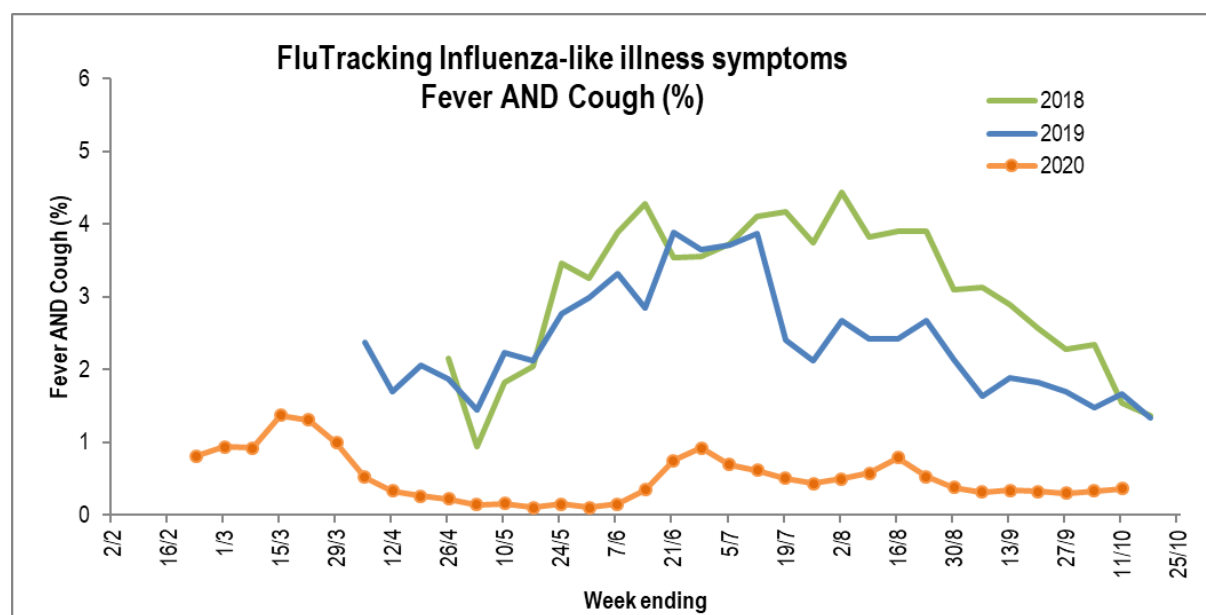
Across New Zealand, fever and cough was reported by 0.4% participants. Fever, cough and absence from normal duties was reported by 0.2% participants. Fever and cough was reported by 2.0% of participants aged less than 5 years, 0.2% of participants aged 5-17 years, 0.4% of participants aged 18-64 years, and 0.2% of participants aged 65 years or older.

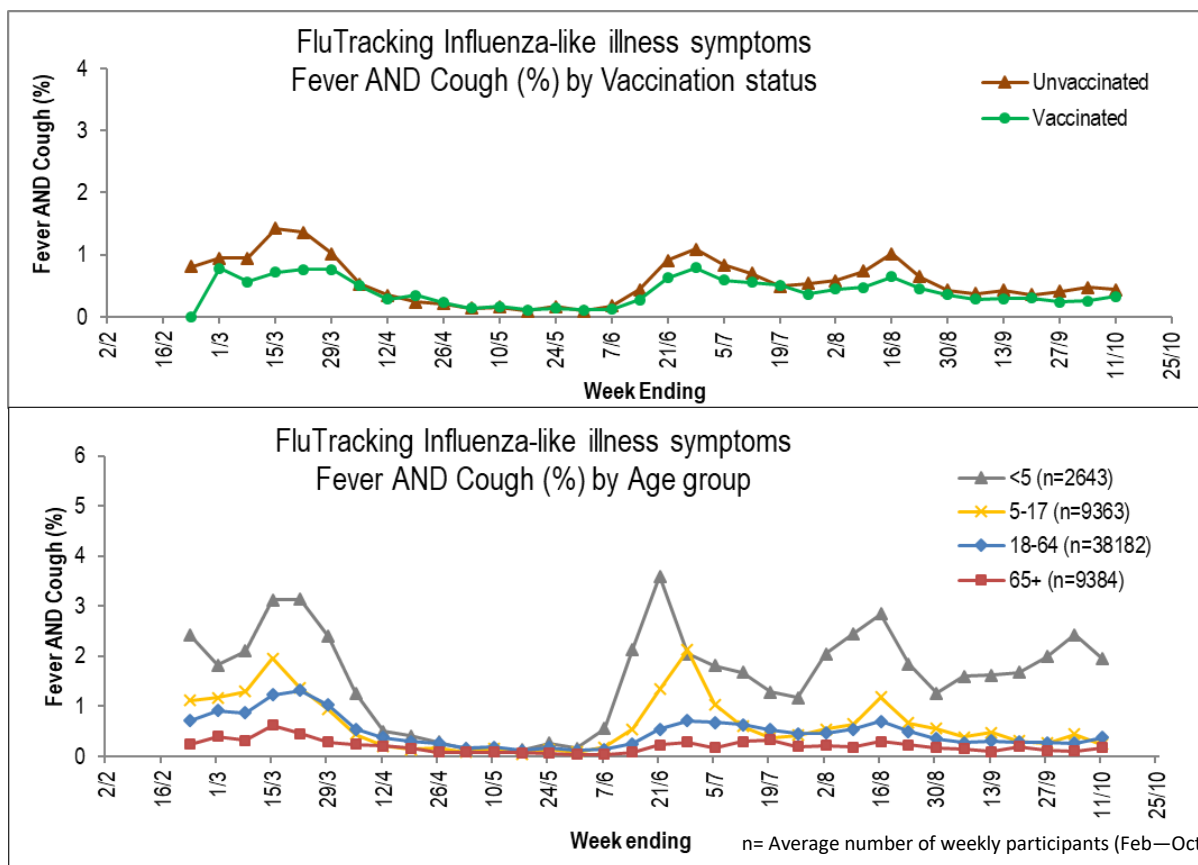
