This survey was sent on Monday, 30 November 2020 at 03:11 AM and by 09:00 AM, Thursday 03 December we had received 21550 responses (24225 last week) from 11901 people responding for themselves and 9649 household members across New Zealand.

Across New Zealand, Fever AND Cough was reported by 0.7% participants. Fever, cough and absence from normal duties was reported by 0.5% participants.

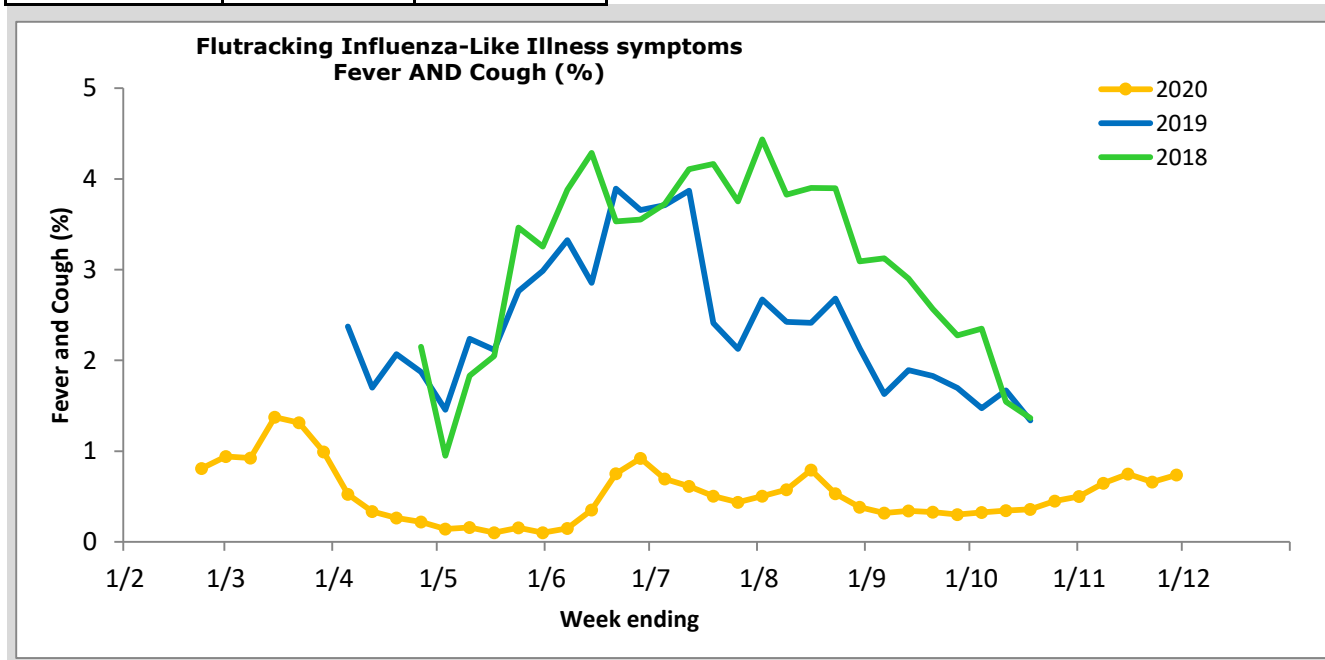
Fever AND cough was reported by 6.0% of participants aged less than 5 years, 1.0% of participants aged 5-17 years, 0.6% of participants aged 18-64 years, and 0.3% of participants aged 65 years or older.
