

Weekly Interim Report New Zealand

Week ending 10 January 2021

Low levels of influenza-like illness activity
(FluTracking is an online self-reporting ILI surveillance system.
Care should be taken when interpreting this report)

This survey was sent on Monday, 11 January 2021 at 03:11 AM and by 09:00 AM, Thursday 14 January we had received 17966 responses (17039 last week) from 10224 people responding for themselves and 7742 household members across New Zealand.

Across New Zealand, Fever AND Cough was reported by 0.3% participants. Fever, cough and absence from normal duties was reported by 0.2% participants.

Fever AND cough was reported by 0.2% of participants aged less than 5 years, 0.2% of participants aged 5-17 years, 0.3% of participants aged 18-64 years, and 0.3% of participants aged 65 years or older.
