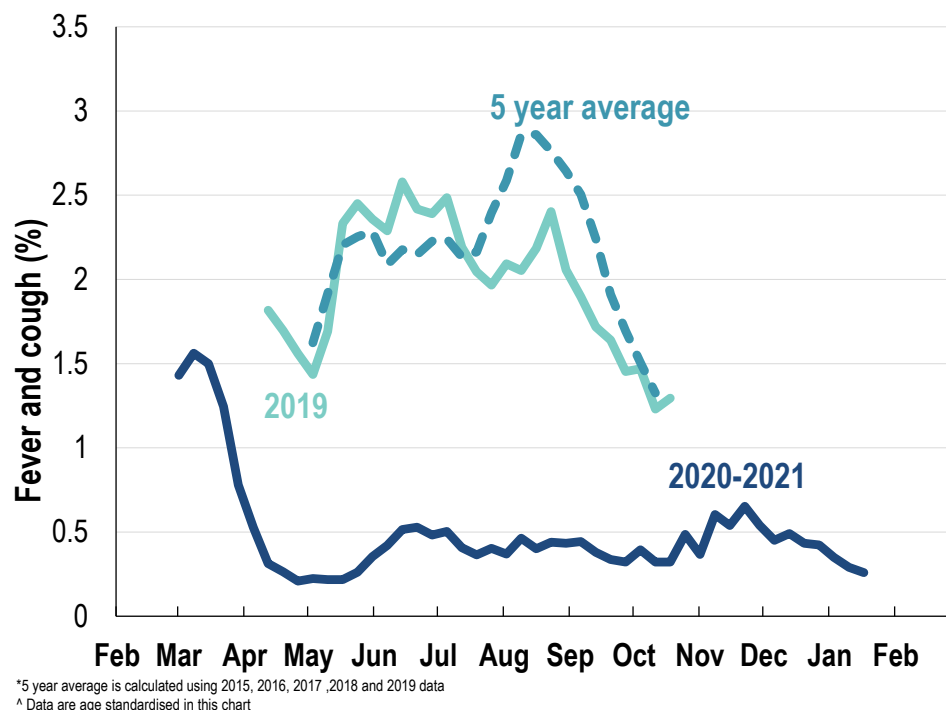


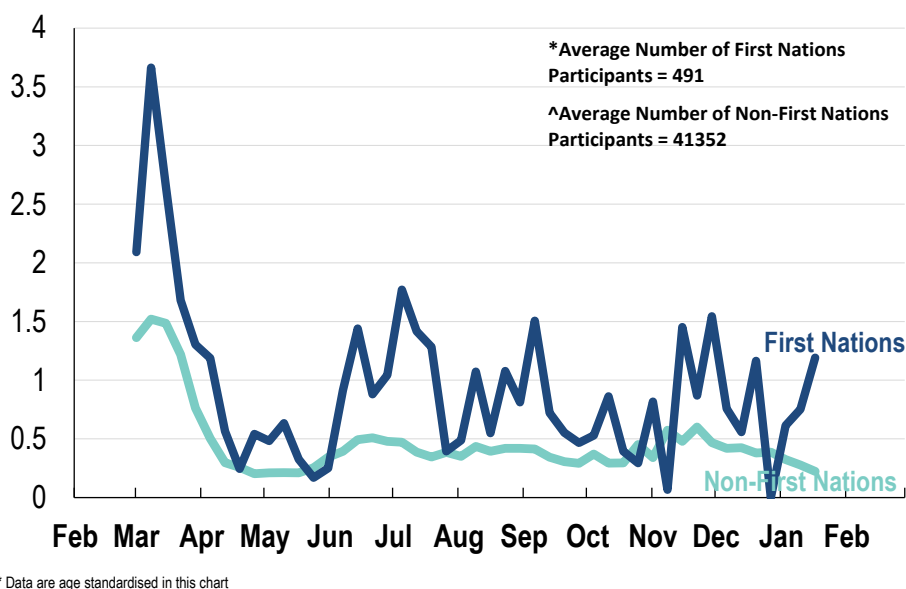
This week influenza-like illness activity is low 38,360 participants this week

Influenza-like illness activity by Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander status:

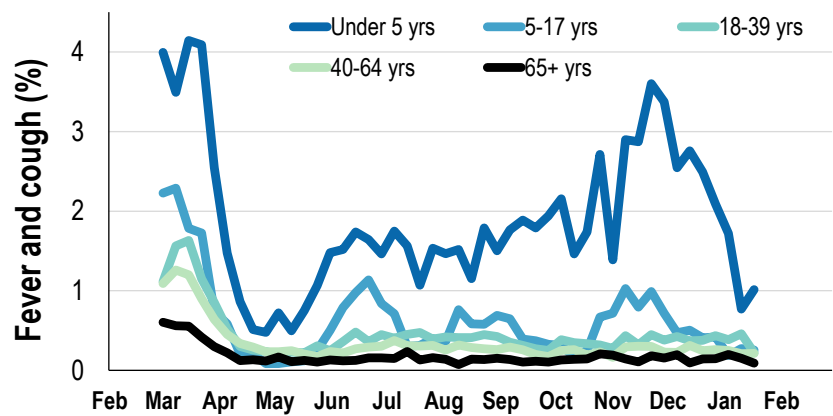


Influenza-like illness severity:
62.7% of participants with fever and cough sought medical advice this week

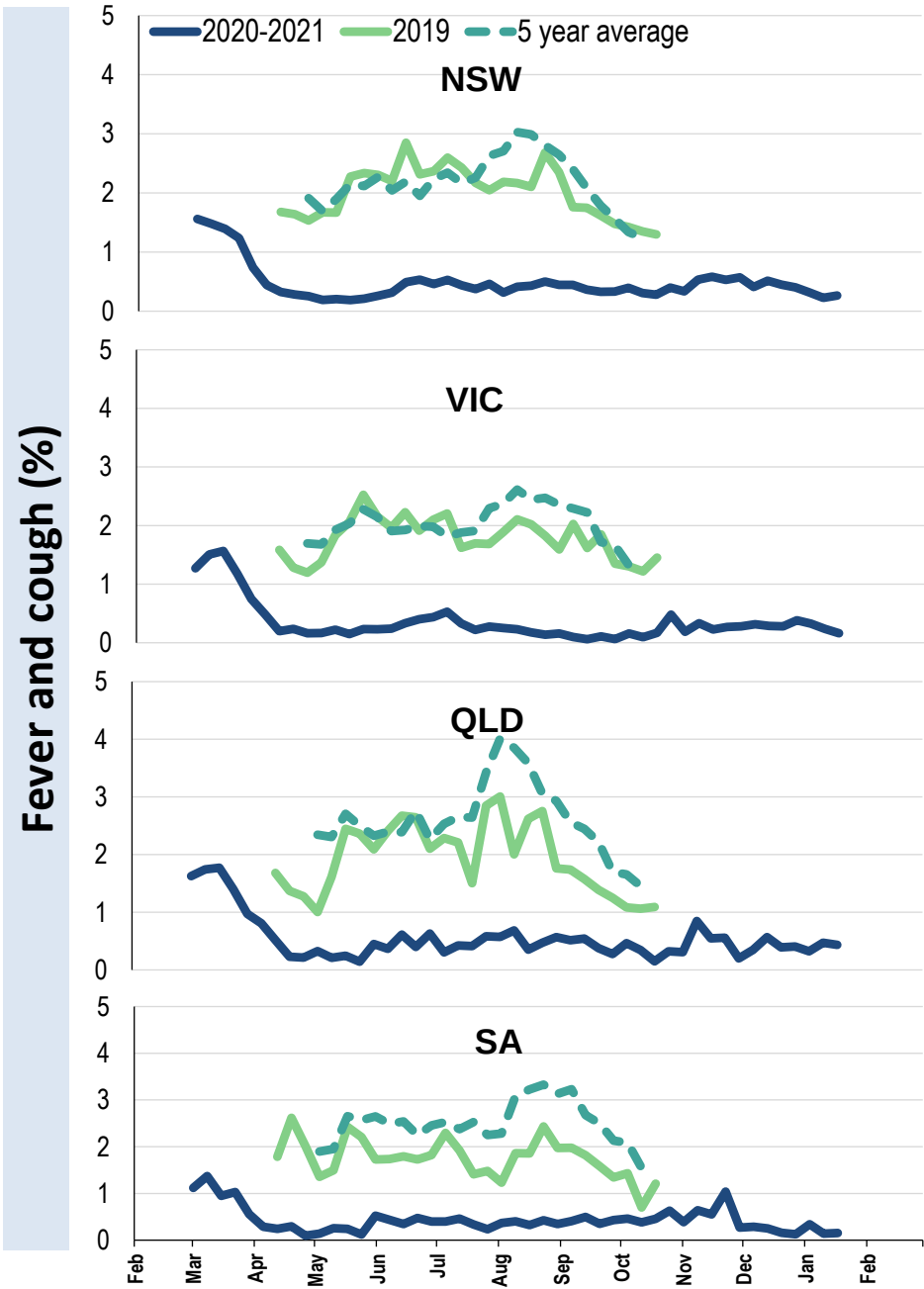

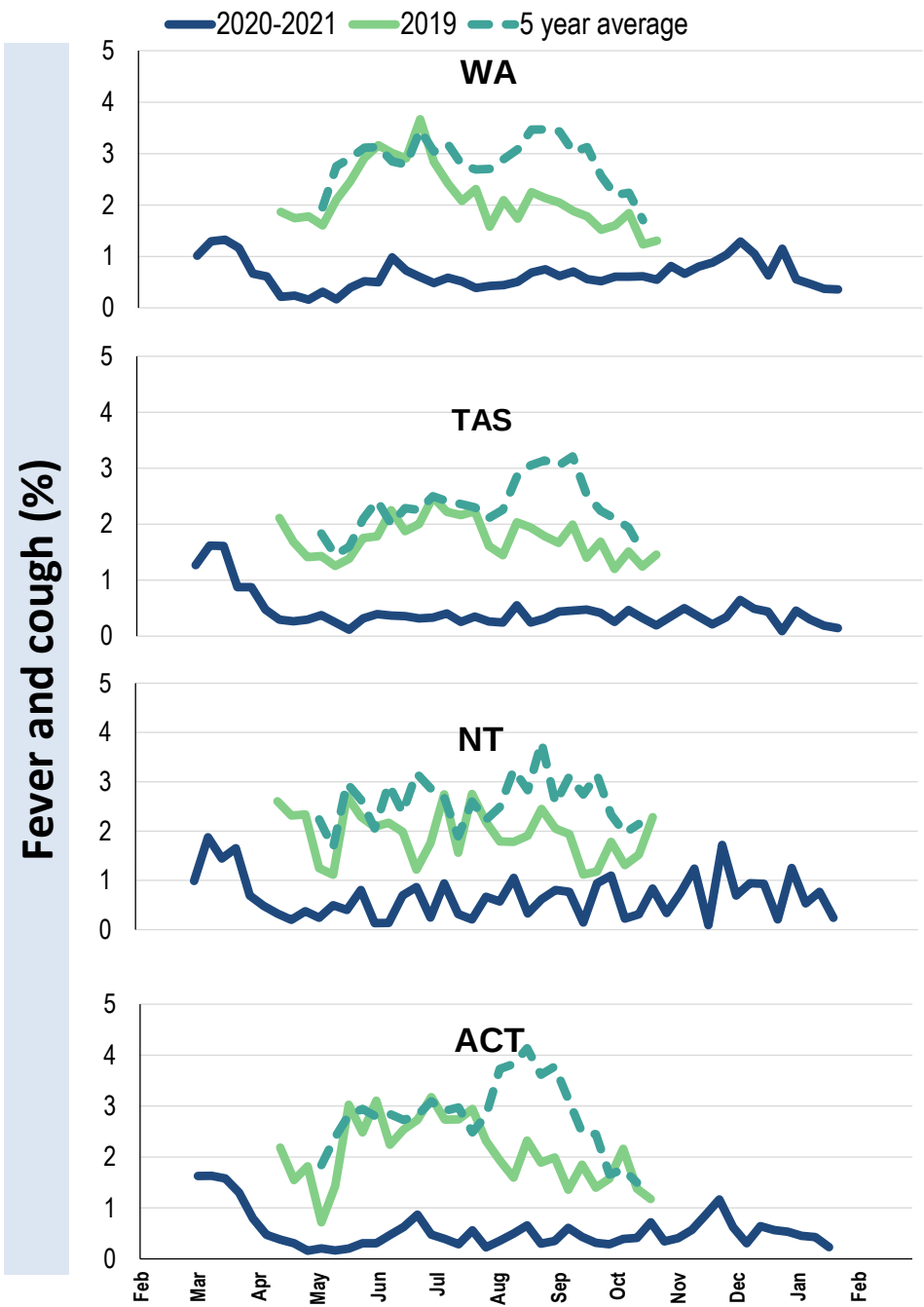
Influenza-like illness activity by age group (Australia):
