

# Weekly Interim Report New Zealand

**Week ending 27 March 2022**

**Low levels of influenza-like illness activity**  
**(FluTracking is an online self-reporting ILI surveillance system.**  
**Care should be taken when interpreting this report)**

This survey was sent on Monday, 28 March 2022 at 01:11 am and by 08:30 am, Thursday 31 March we had received 33188 responses (33774 last week) from 19164 people responding for themselves and 14024 household members across New Zealand.


## Self-reported COVID-19 and influenza testing



Tested for influenza (% of fever & cough)	9 (1.8%)	11 (2.1%)
Tested for COVID-19 (% of fever & cough)	29 (5.9%)	39 (7.4%)
Result positive for influenza (% of fever & cough)	2 (0.4%)	2 (0.4%)
Result positive for COVID-19 (% of fever & cough)	9 (1.8%)	17 (3.2%)

Across New Zealand, Fever AND Cough was reported by 1.5% participants. Fever, cough and absence from normal duties was reported by 1.2% participants. Fever AND cough was reported by 3.9% of participants aged less than 5 years, 2.8% of participants aged 5-17 years, 1.6% of participants aged 18-64 years, and 0.5% of participants aged 65 years or older.
