

# Weekly Interim Report New Zealand

# Week ending 19 June 2022

## Low levels of influenza-like illness activity (FluTracking is an online self-reporting ILI surveillance system. Care should be taken when interpreting this report)

This survey was sent on Monday, 20 June 2022 at 01:11 am and by 08:30 am, Thursday 23 June we had received 44304 responses (44346 last week) from 25984 people responding for themselves and 18320 household members across New Zealand.




Across New Zealand, Fever AND Cough was reported by 2.4% participants. Fever, cough and absence from normal duties was reported by 1.9% participants.

Fever AND cough was reported by 9.9% of participants aged less than 5 years, 6.1% of participants aged 5-17 years, 2.2% of participants aged 18-64 years, and 0.8% of participants aged 65 years or older.
