# Week ending 07 August 2022

### Low levels of influenza-like illness activity (FluTracking is an online self-reporting ILI surveillance system. Care should be taken when interpreting this report)

This survey was sent on Monday, 08 August 2022 at 01:11 am and by 08:30 am, Thursday 11 August we had received 43114 responses (43249 last week) from 25535 people responding for themselves and 17579 household members across New Zealand.




Across New Zealand, Fever AND Cough was reported by 1.8% participants. Fever, cough and absence from normal duties was reported by 1.3% participants.

Fever AND cough was reported by 8.5% of participants aged less than 5 years, 3.1% of participants aged 5-17 years, 1.9% of participants aged 18-64 years, and 0.7% of participants aged 65 years or older.
