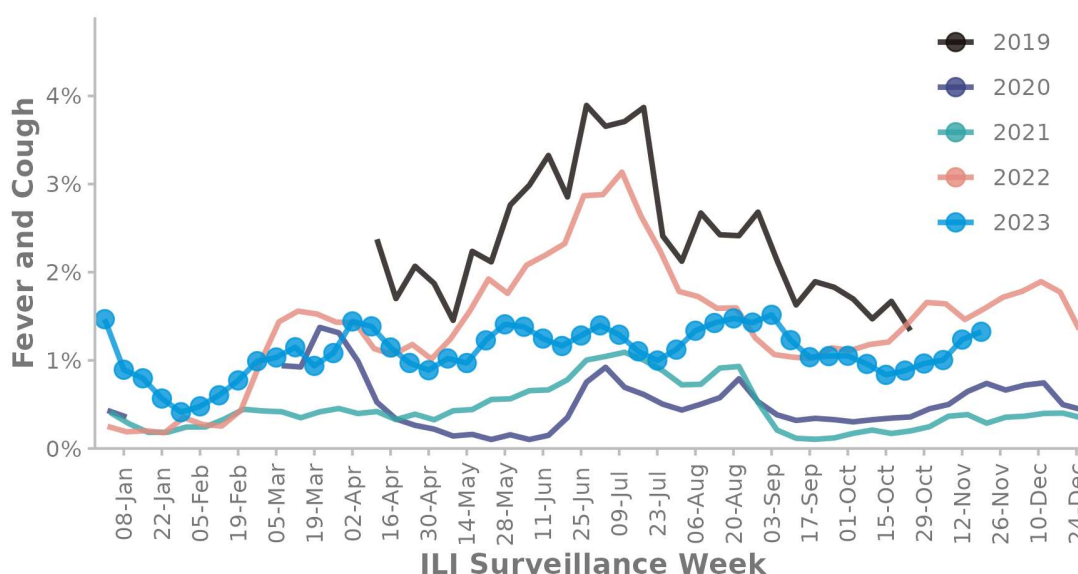

This survey was sent on 20 November 2023 01:01 AM and by 23 November 2023 08:30 am we had received 19,638 responses (22,600 last week) from 12,833 people responding for themselves and 6,805 household members across New Zealand. Please note over the summer period there will be a reduced sample size for FluTracking, as participants have been given the option to opt-out until April 2024.

Across New Zealand, fever AND cough was reported by 1.3% of participants. Fever, cough and absence from normal duties was reported by 0.9% participants. fever AND cough was reported by 8.3% of participants aged less than 5 years, 1.5% of participants aged 5-17 years, 1.4% of participants aged 18-64 years, and 1% of participants aged 65 years or older.

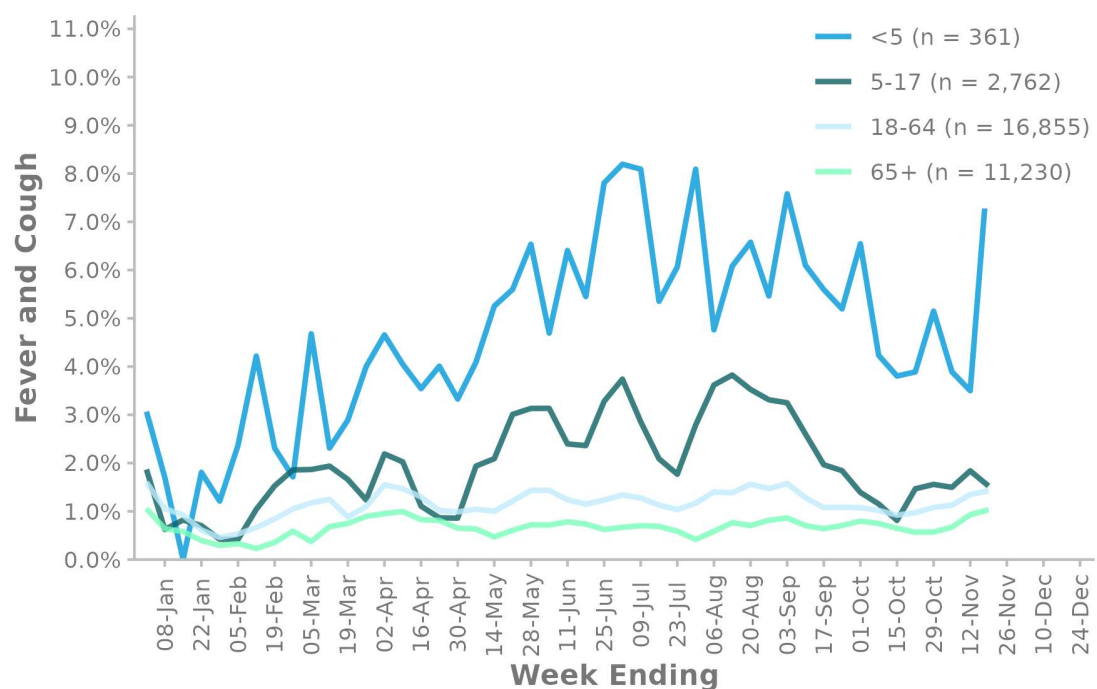
