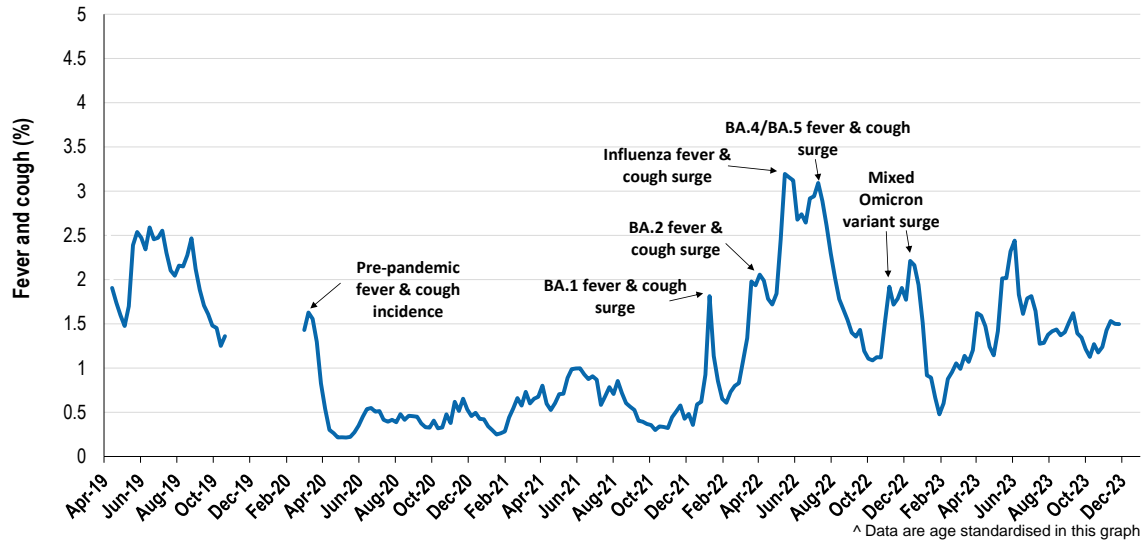


Figure 2- Respiratory illness activity among Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander participants

0.6% this week and 1.8% last week

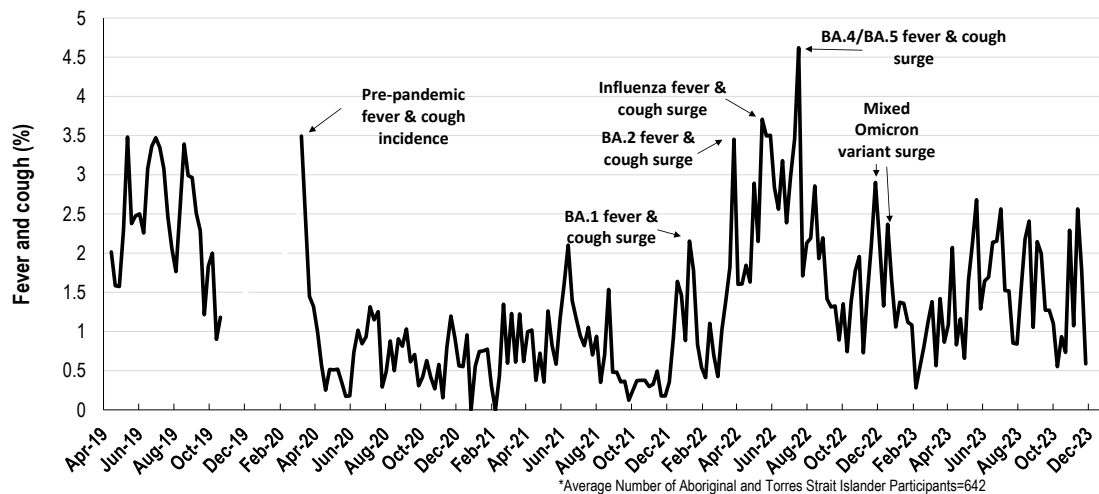
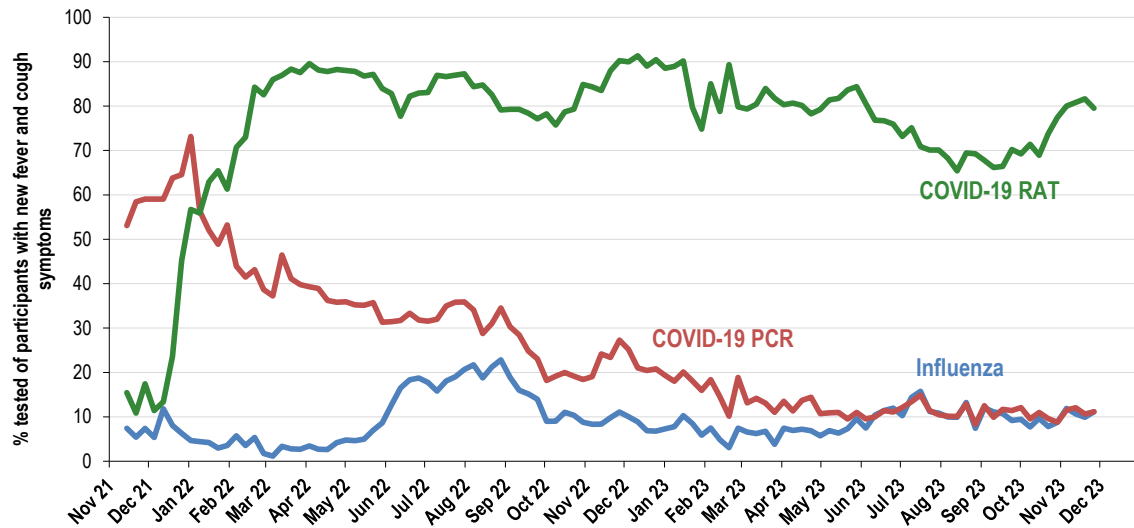
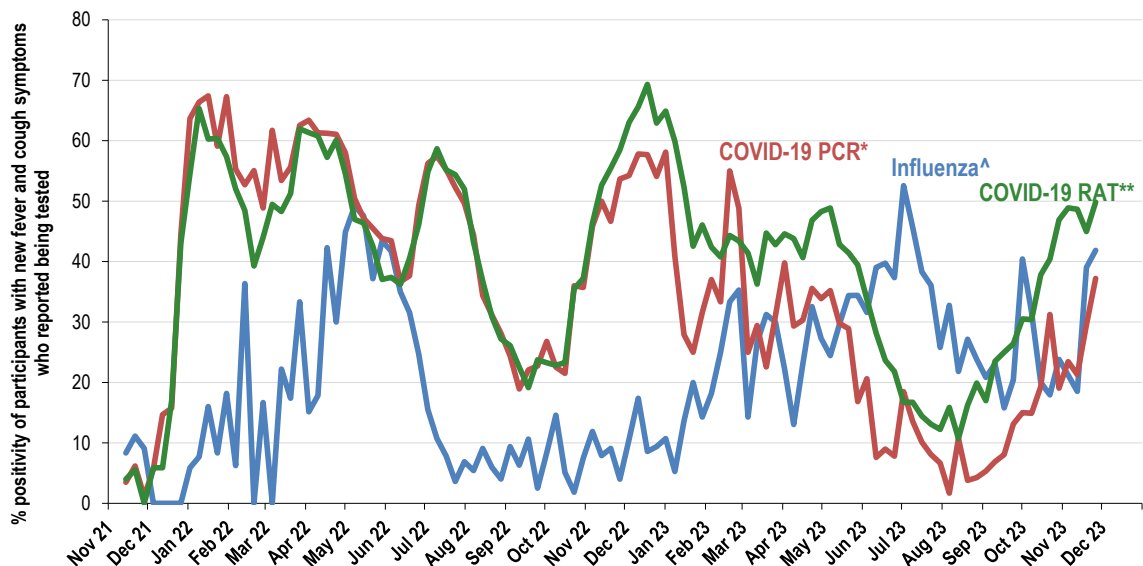


Figure 3- Fever, cough and reported testing for COVID-19 or influenza

^Denominator= participants who self-reported fever and cough symptoms and had an influenza test

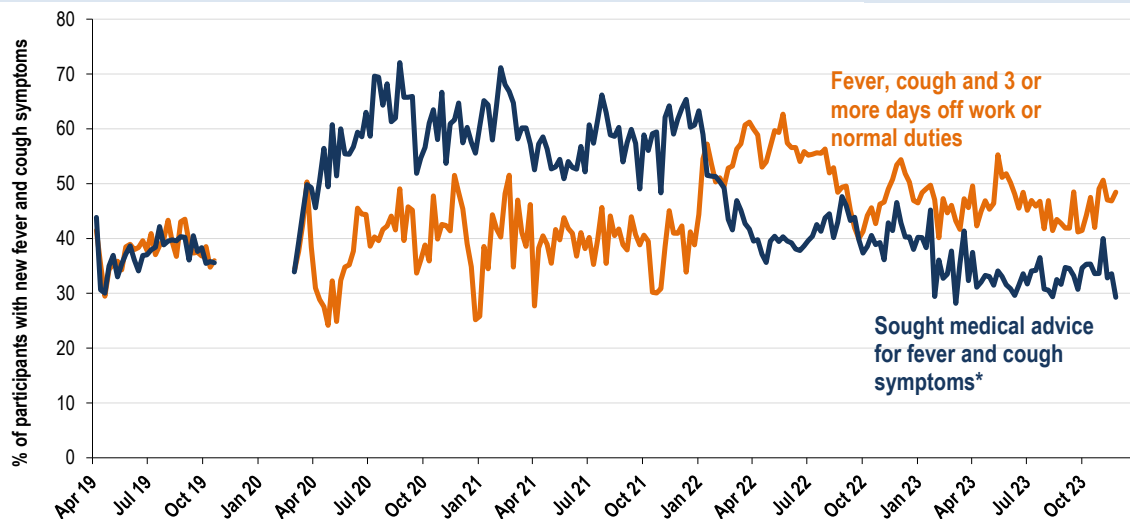

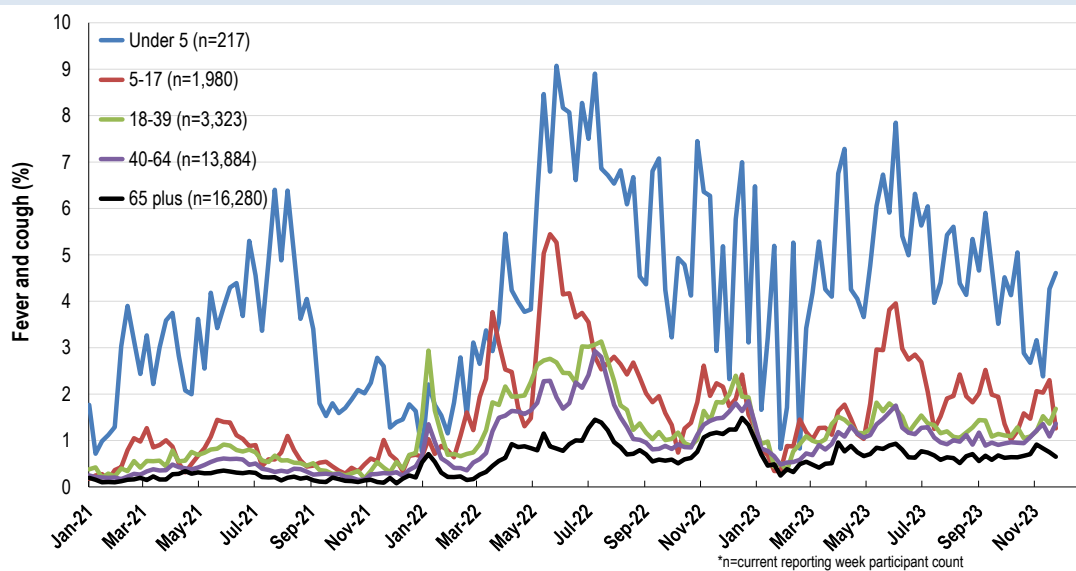

Figure 5- Severity of Respiratory Illness Activity


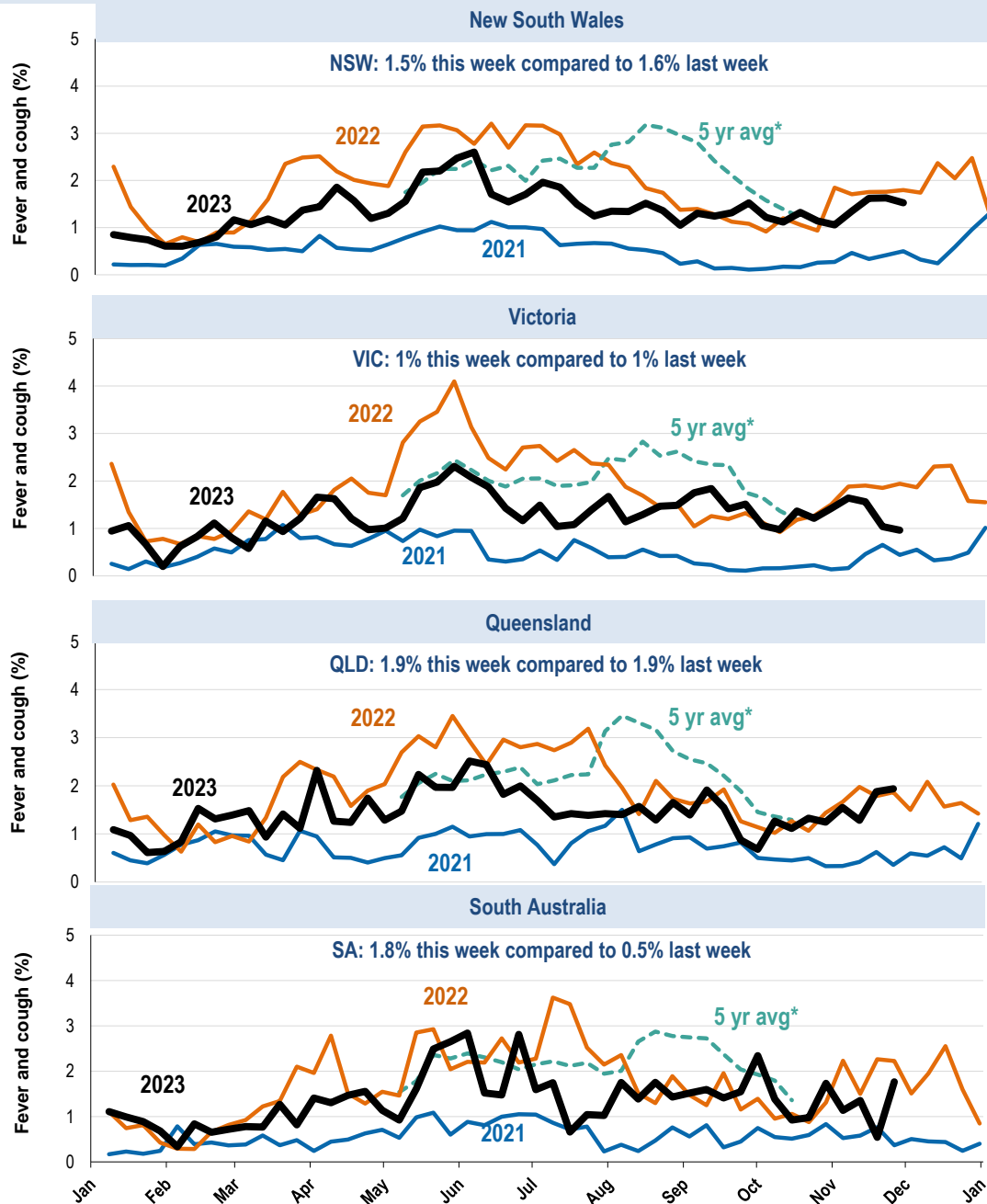

Figure 6- Respiratory illness activity by age group


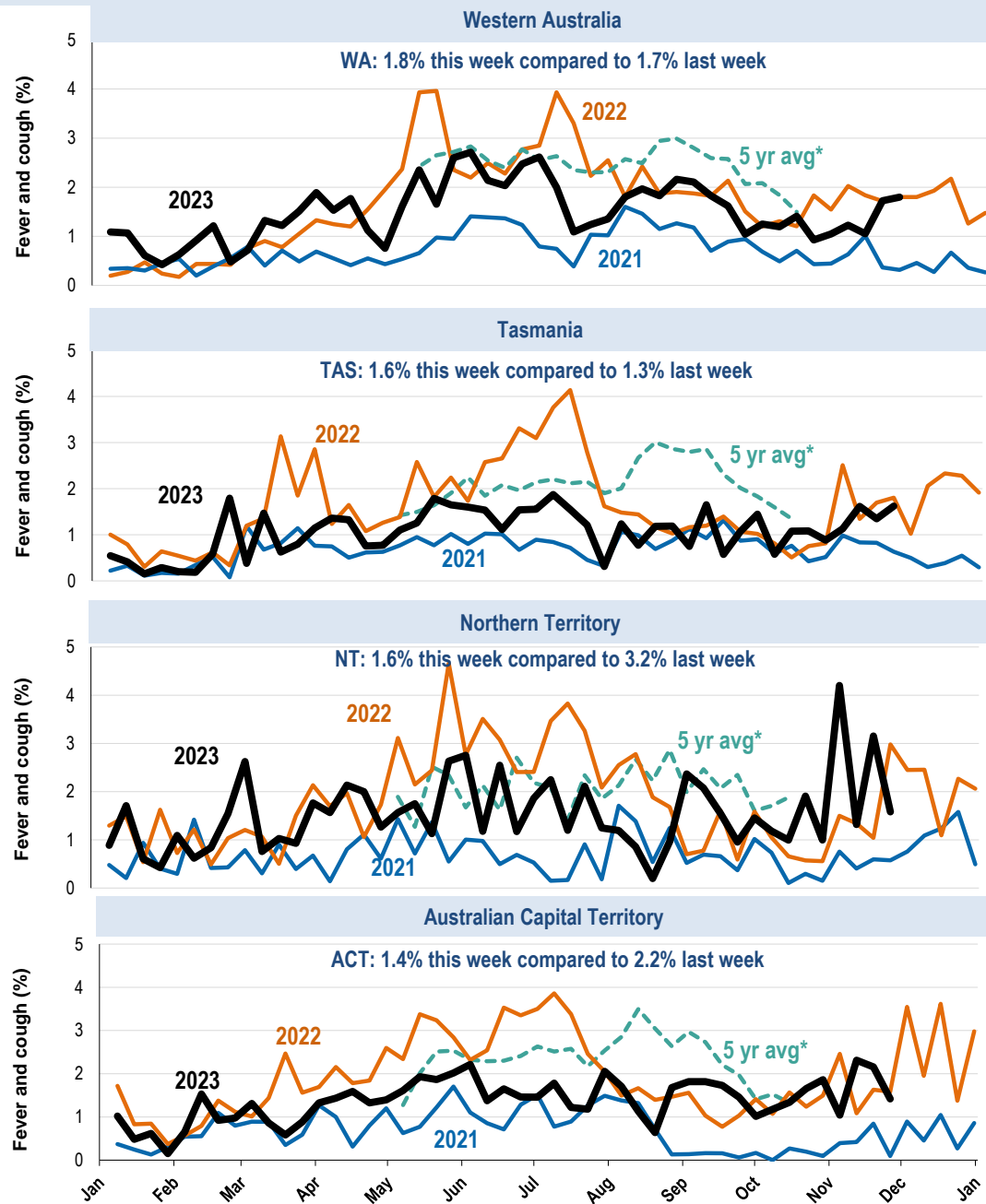

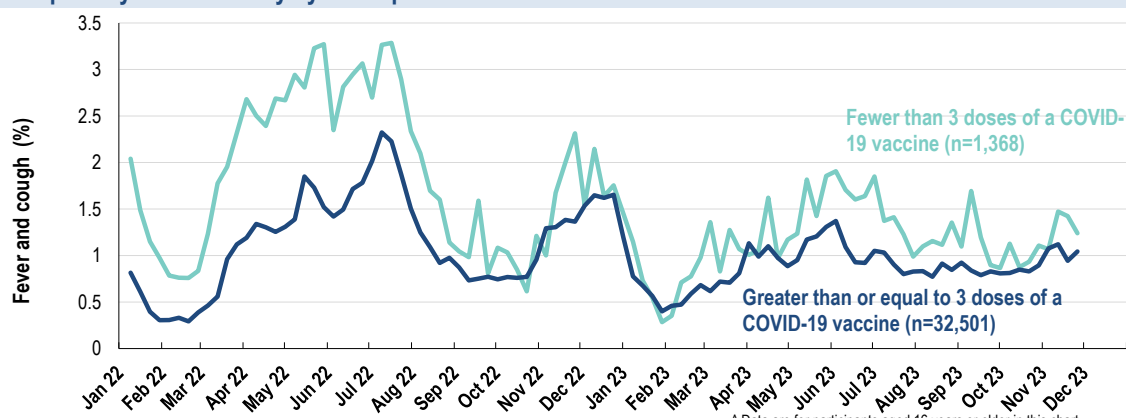

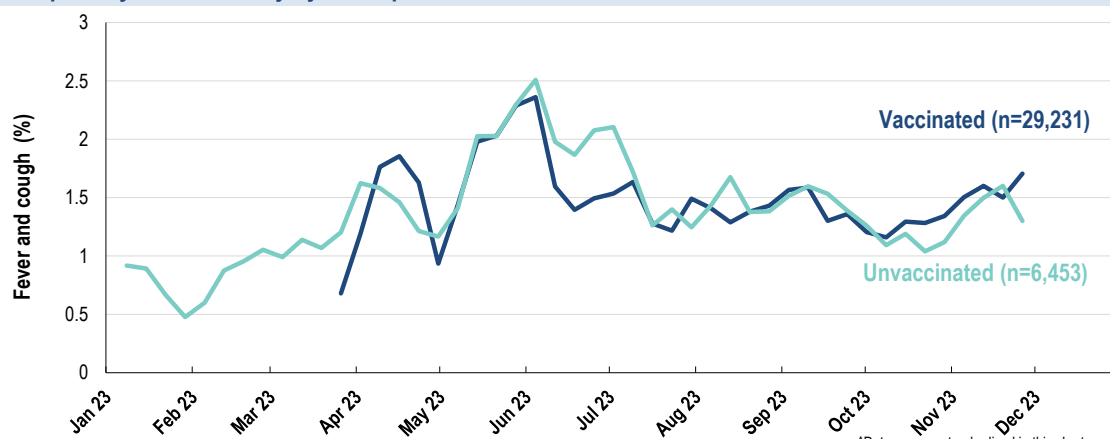
Figure 8- Respiratory illness activity by self-reported COVID-19 vaccination status
