

## Respiratory illness levels have decreased this week




**Figure 1- Respiratory illness activity\***



**Figure 2- Respiratory illness activity among Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander participants**

**1.2% this week and 0.8% last week**






### Figure 3- Fever, cough and reported testing for COVID-19 or influenza

### Figure 4- Fever, cough and reported a positive test result for COVID-19 or influenza



 COVID-19 PCR % positivity: 21.2% (7/33) this week compared to 33.3% last week




### Figure 5- Severity of Respiratory Illness Activity

Sought medical advice for FC: 30.4% (109/358) this week compared to 35.3% last week


### Figure 6- Respiratory illness activity by age group



\*n=current reporting week participant count




### Figure 7- Respiratory illness activity by state/territory (age standardised)

\*5 year average is calculated using 2015, 2016, 2017, 2018 and 2019 data




