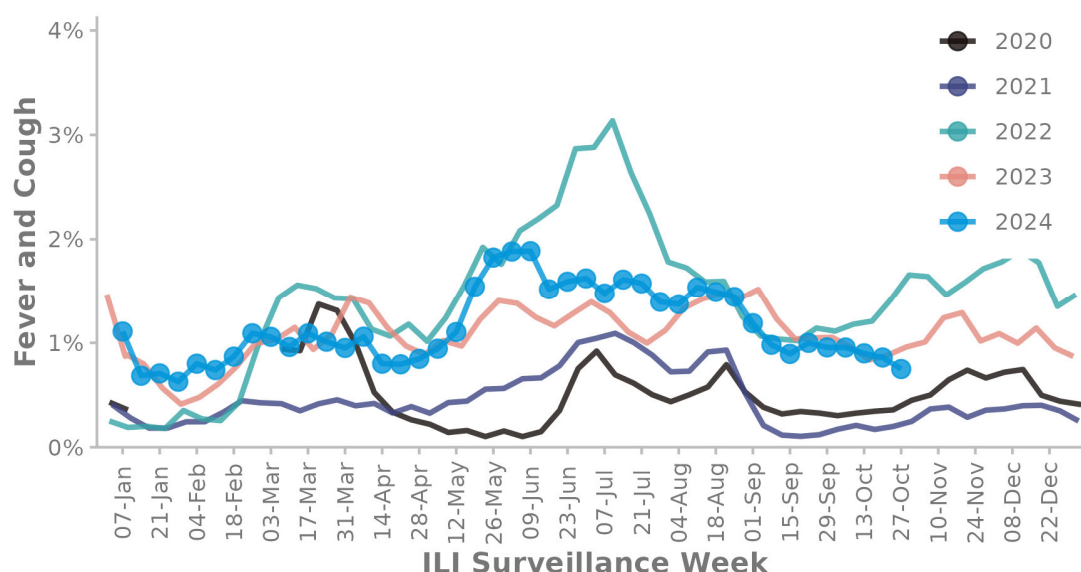

This survey was sent on 28 October 2024 01:01 AM and by 31 October 2024 08:30 am we had received 31,662 responses (31,343 last week) from 20,357 people responding for themselves and 11,305 household members across New Zealand.

Across New Zealand, fever AND cough was reported by 0.7% of participants. Fever, cough and absence from normal duties was reported by 0.5% participants. fever AND cough was reported by 4.4% of participants aged less than 5 years, 1% of participants aged 5-17 years, 0.9% of participants aged 18-64 years, and 0.5% of participants aged 65 years or older.

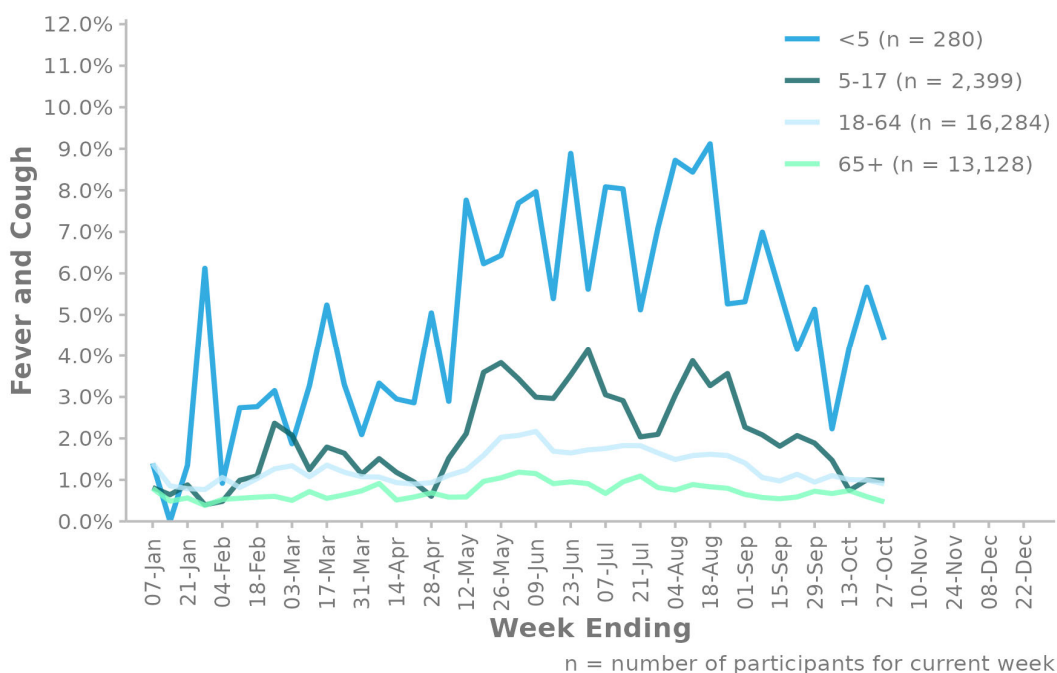
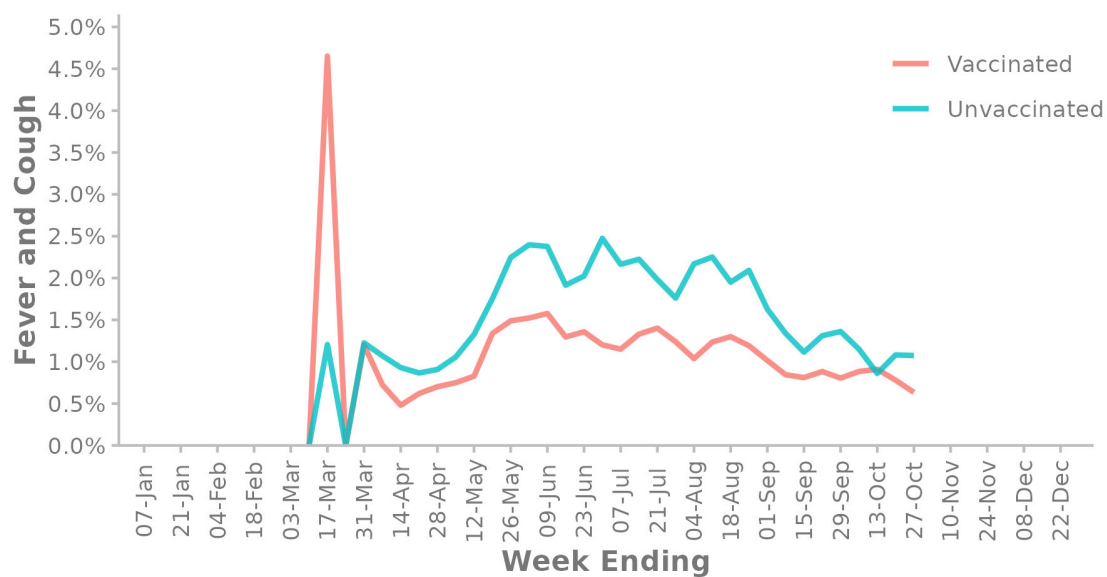


FIGURE 3. FLUTRACKING FEVER AND COUGH SYMPTOMS BY INFLUENZA VACCINATION STATUS
