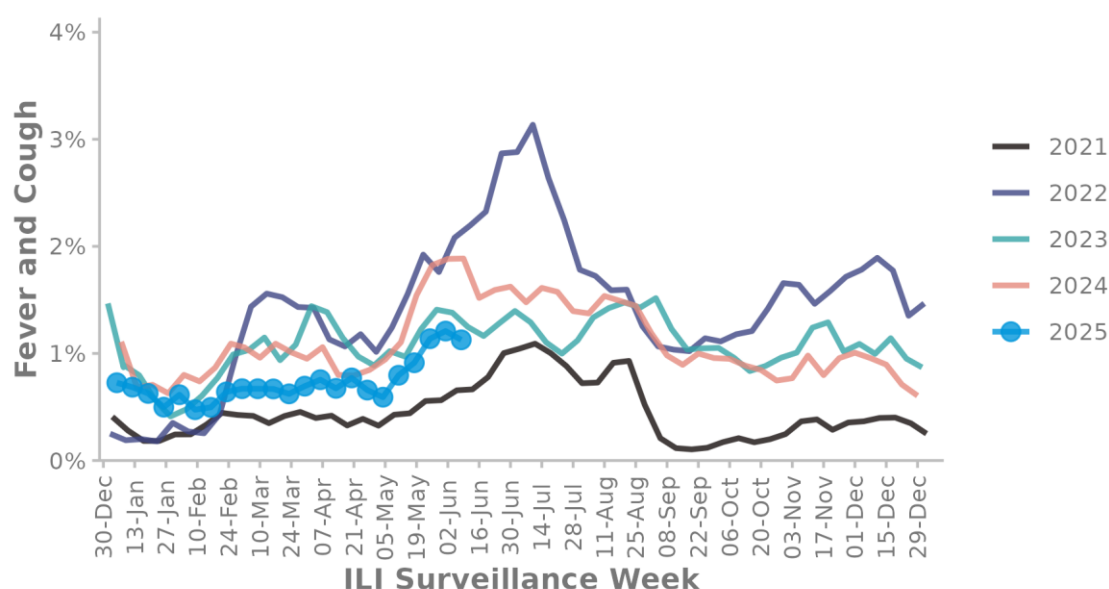

FIGURE 1. FLUTRACKING FEVER AND COUGH SYMPTOMS



This survey was sent on 09 June 2025 01:01 AM and by 12 June 2025 08:30 am we had received 31,053 responses (30,818 last week) from 20,119 people responding for themselves and 10,934 household members across New Zealand.

Across New Zealand, fever AND cough was reported by 1.1% of participants. Fever, cough and absence from normal duties was reported by 0.8% participants. Fever AND cough was reported by 6.7% of participants aged less than 5 years, 1.8% of participants aged 5-17 years, 1.4% of participants aged 18-64 years, and 0.7% of participants aged 65 years or older.

FIGURE 2. FLUTRACKING FEVER AND COUGH SYMPTOMS BY AGE GROUP

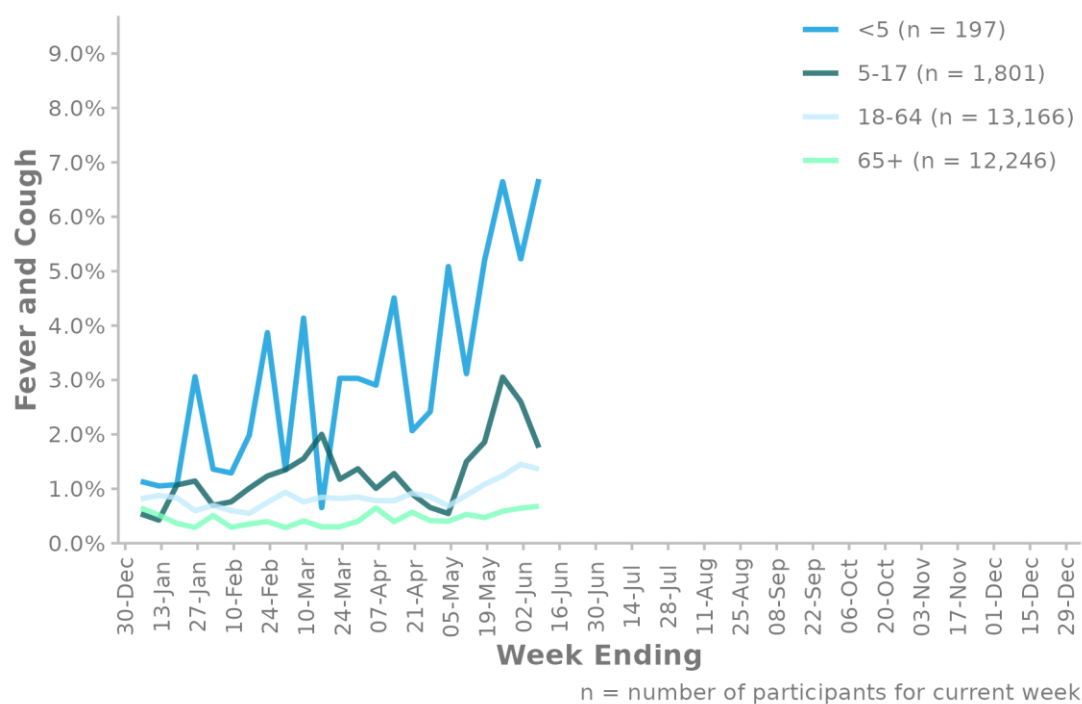
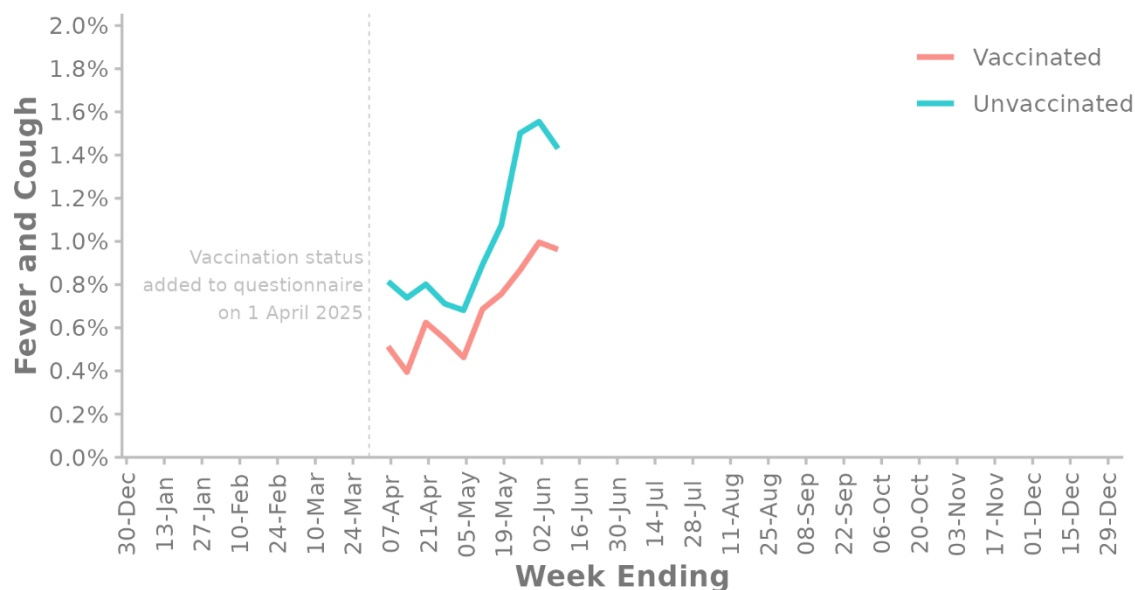


FIGURE 3. FLUTRACKING FEVER AND COUGH SYMPTOMS BY INFLUENZA VACCINATION STATUS
