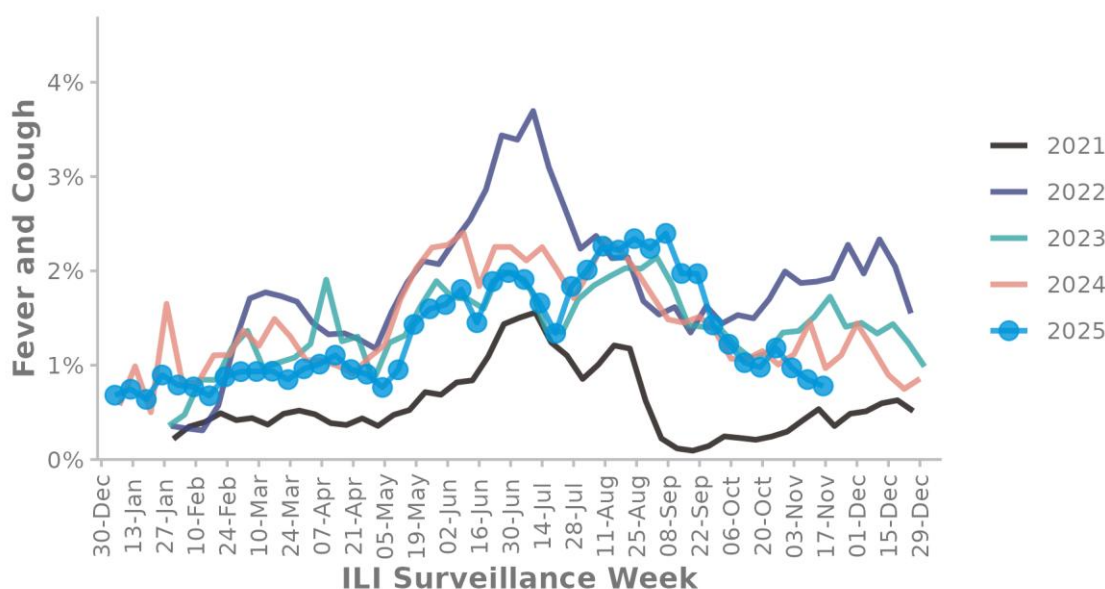

FIGURE 1. FLUTRACKING FEVER AND COUGH SYMPTOMS



This survey was sent in the early hours of 17 November 2025 and by 20 November 2025 08:30 am we had received 19,981 responses (28,641 last week) from 13,565 people responding for themselves and 6,416 household members across New Zealand.

Across New Zealand, fever AND cough was reported by 0.8% of participants. Fever, cough and absence from normal duties was reported by 0.5% participants. Fever AND cough was reported by 2.8% of participants aged less than 5 years, 1% of participants aged 5-19 years, 0.8% of participants aged 20-64 years, and 0.4% of participants aged 65 years or older.

The incidence calculation has recently been updated. Numbers from this report will currently not match incidence on the [New Zealand Influenza Intelligence Report](#). The data presented here should not be treated as authoritative and should always be interpreted together with other trusted sources from the [New Zealand Influenza Intelligence Report](#)

FIGURE 2. FLUTRACKING FEVER AND COUGH SYMPTOMS BY AGE GROUP

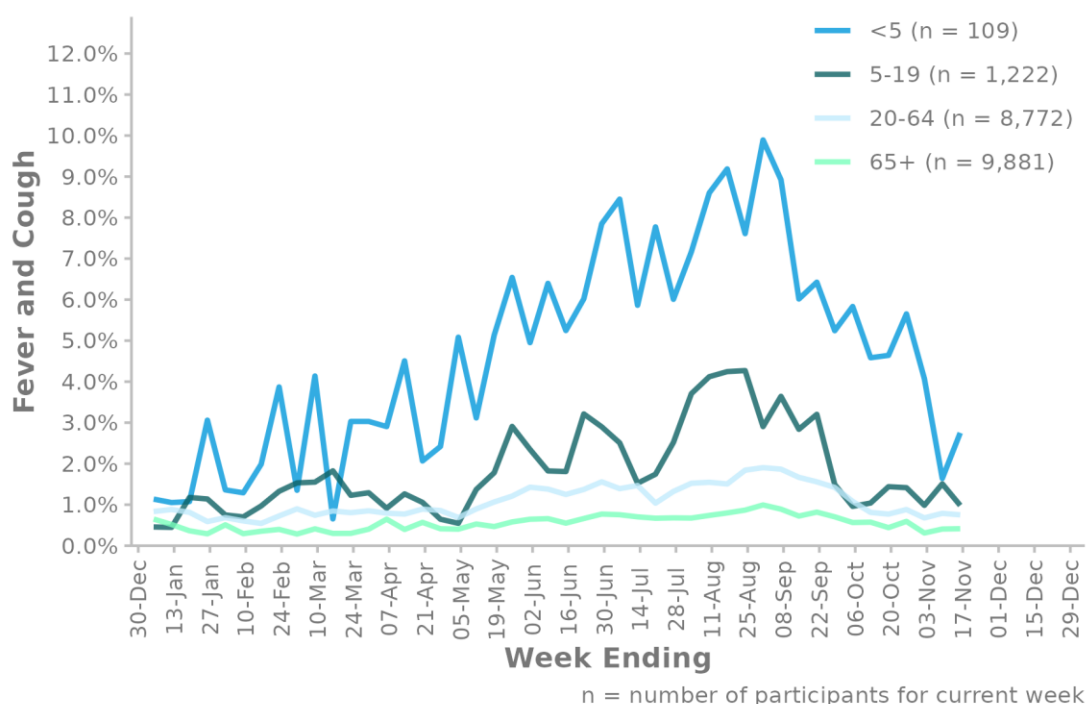
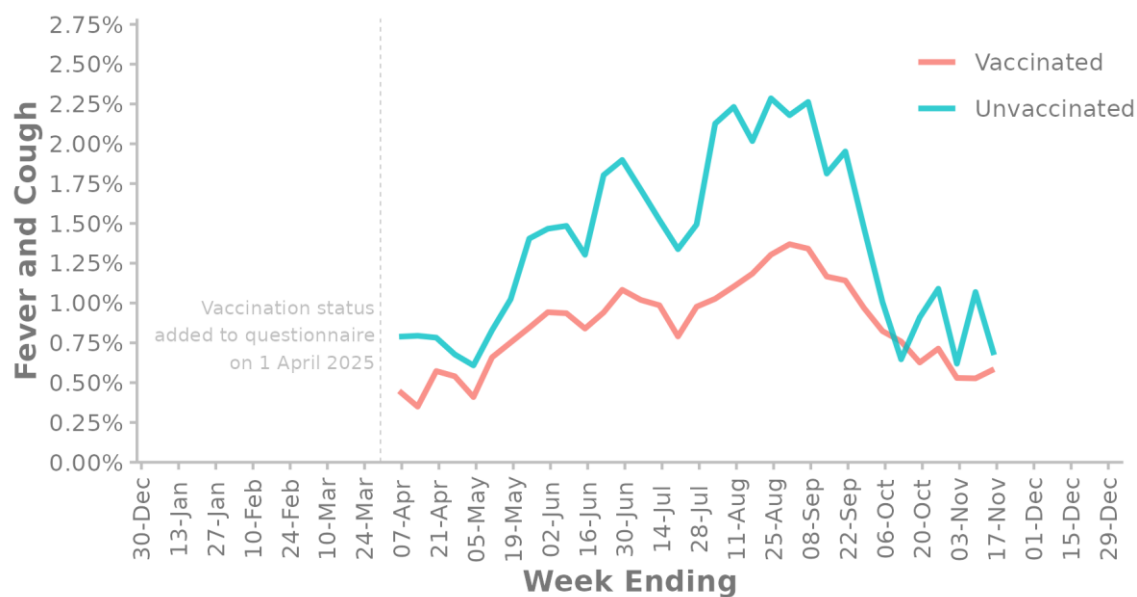


FIGURE 3. FLUTRACKING FEVER AND COUGH SYMPTOMS BY INFLUENZA VACCINATION STATUS
